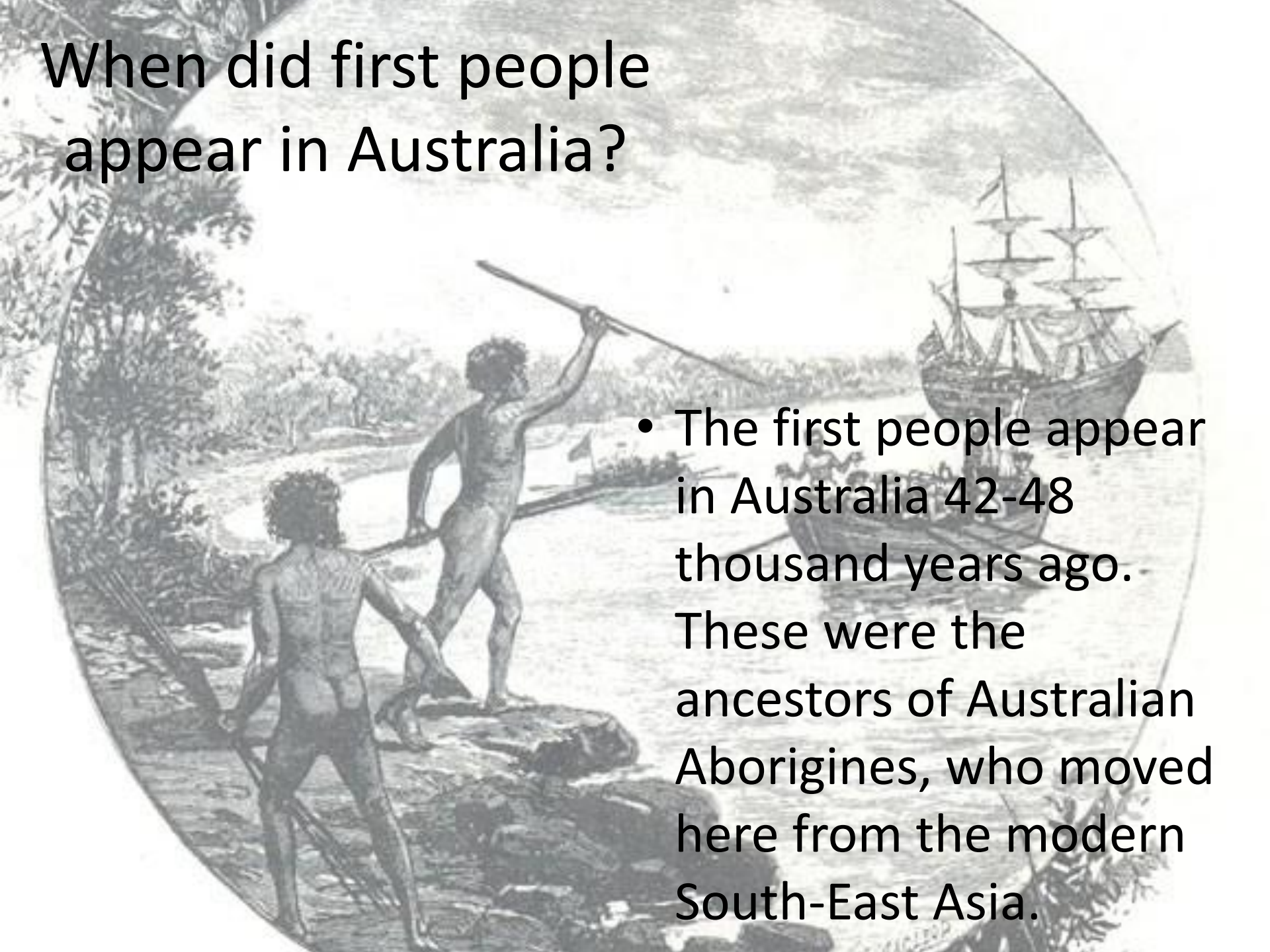


Australia

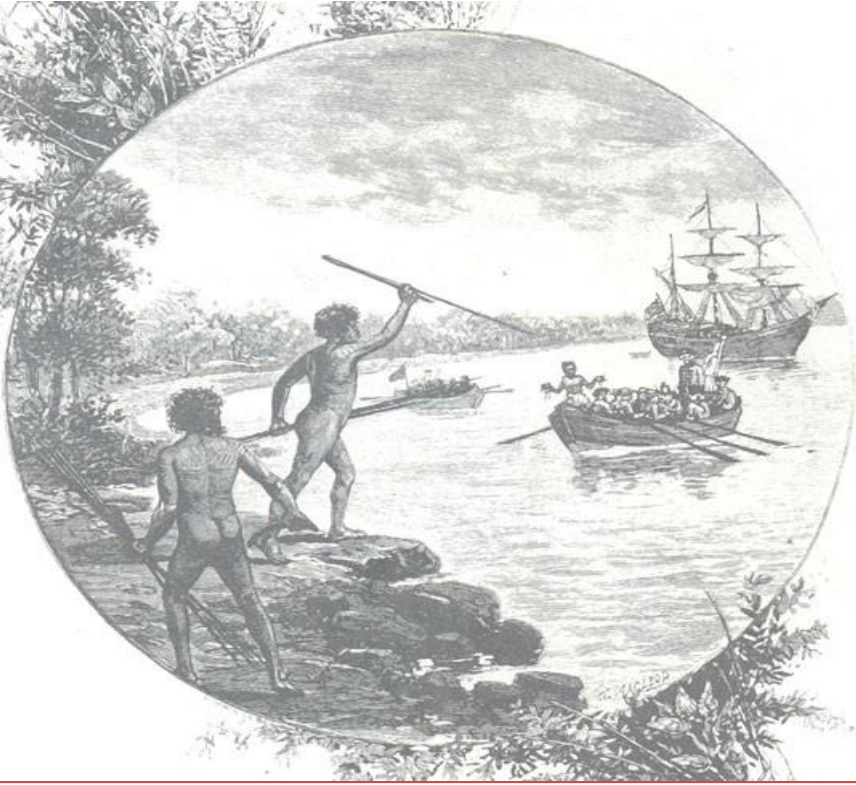
- The Australian landscape isn't boring at all, because in this great flat land there are many wonderful places.

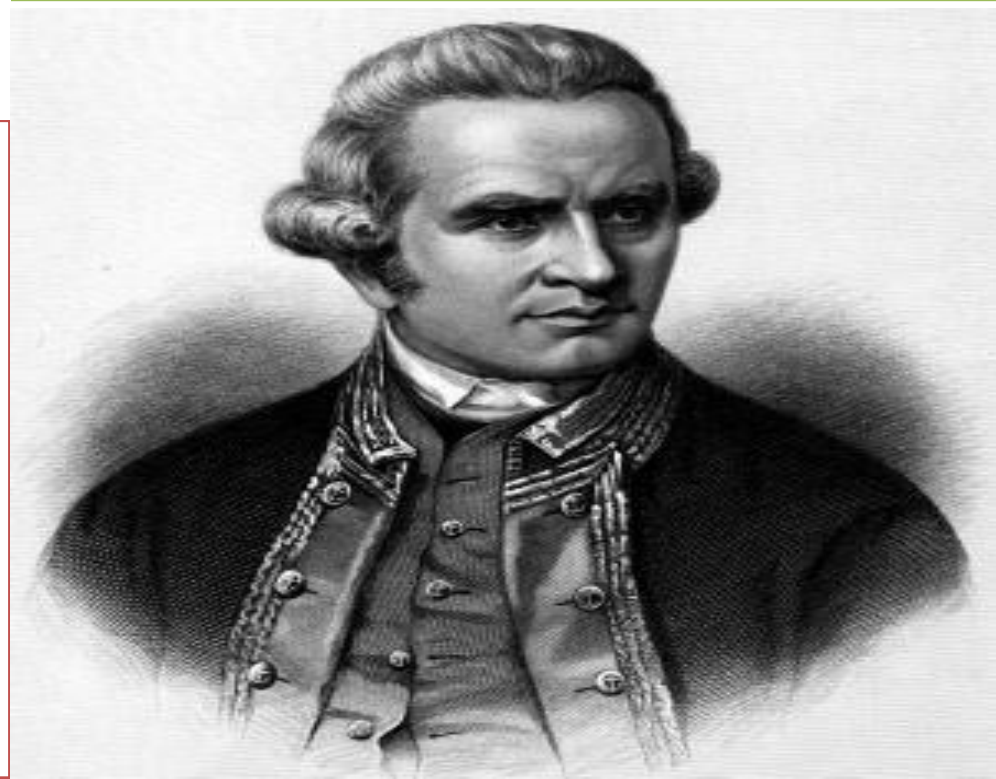
What parts of
