


## **The Coat of Arms**

- Canada's Coat of Arms was officially proclaimed on November 21, 1921.
- The present Coat of Arms was approved in 1994.



# **Symbols of Canada**

- The beaver attained official status as an emblem of Canada March 24, 1975.
- The maple leaf began to serve as a Canadian symbol as early as 1700.
- The colour of the maple leaves on the arms of Canada was changed from green to red in 1957.


# **The Great Seal**

- The Great Seal of Canada is used on all state documents such as proclamations and commissions of:
  - cabinet ministers
  - Senators
  - Judges
  - senior government officials.
- The seal bears the effigy of Queen Elizabeth II, in her robes, holding the orb and sceptre, and shows her sitting on the coronation chair.



# **Origin of the Name – Canada**


- 1. The explorer depicted in the image is Jacques Cartier .
- 2. The Huron-Iroquois word for "village" or "settlement" was kanata.
- 3. The first use of "Canada" as an official name came in 1791 when the Province of Quebec was divided into the colonies of Upper and Lower Canada.
