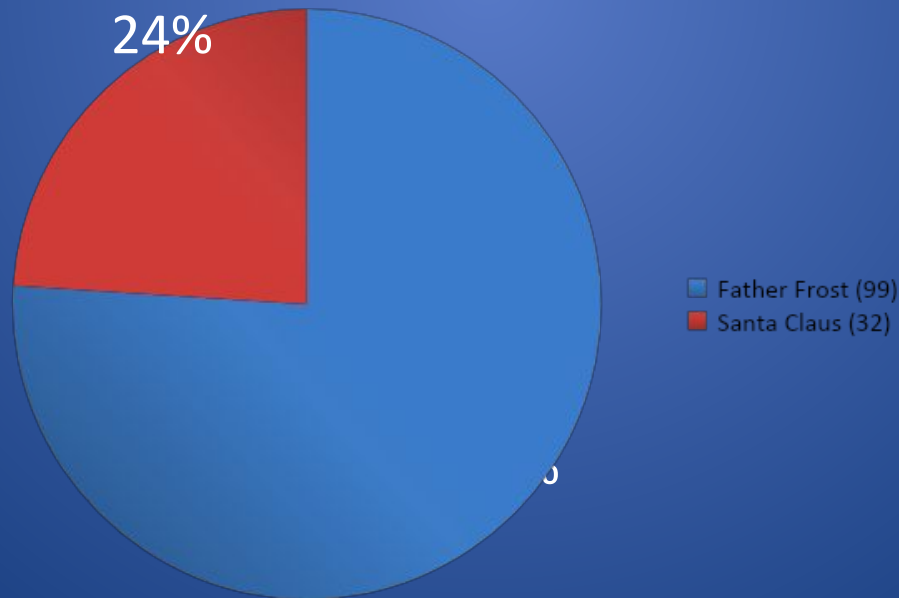
Survey №1

Likes Santa: 32 p.

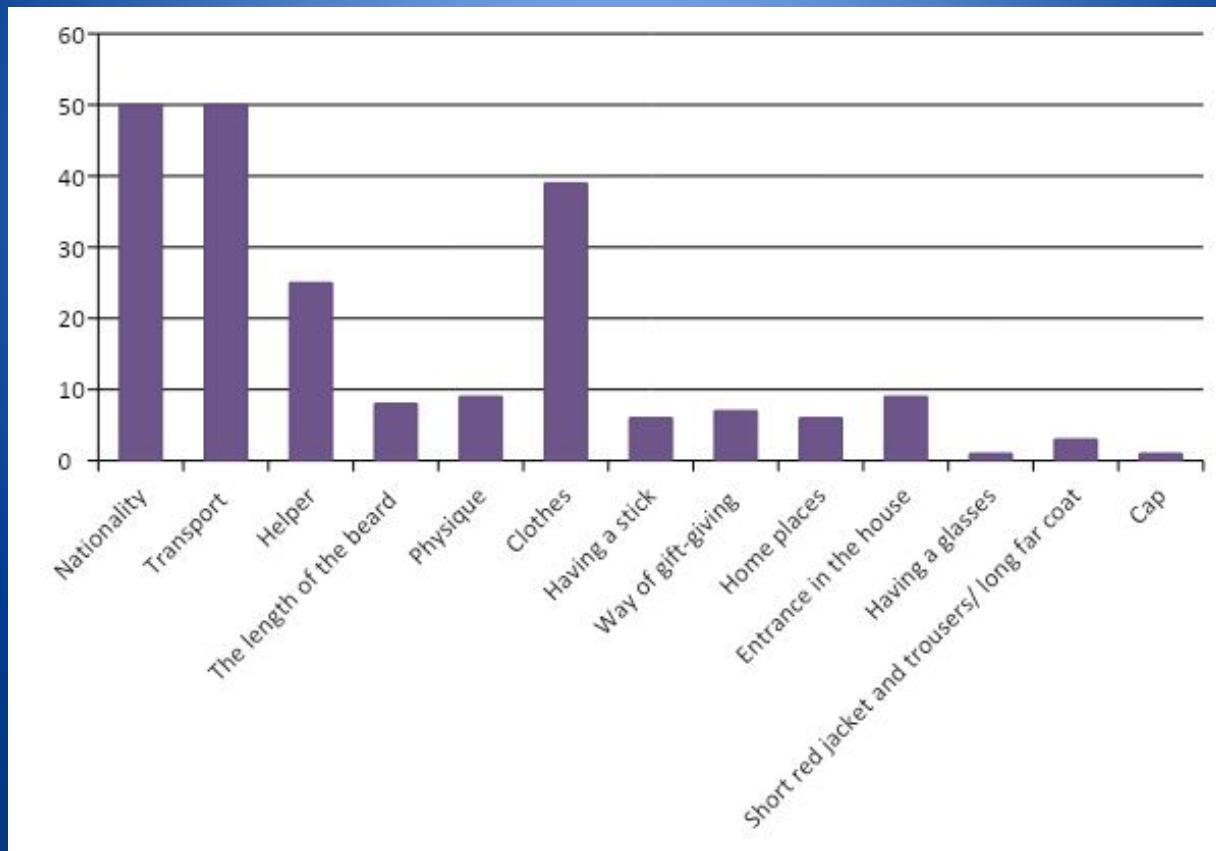
Likes Father Frost: 99 p.
