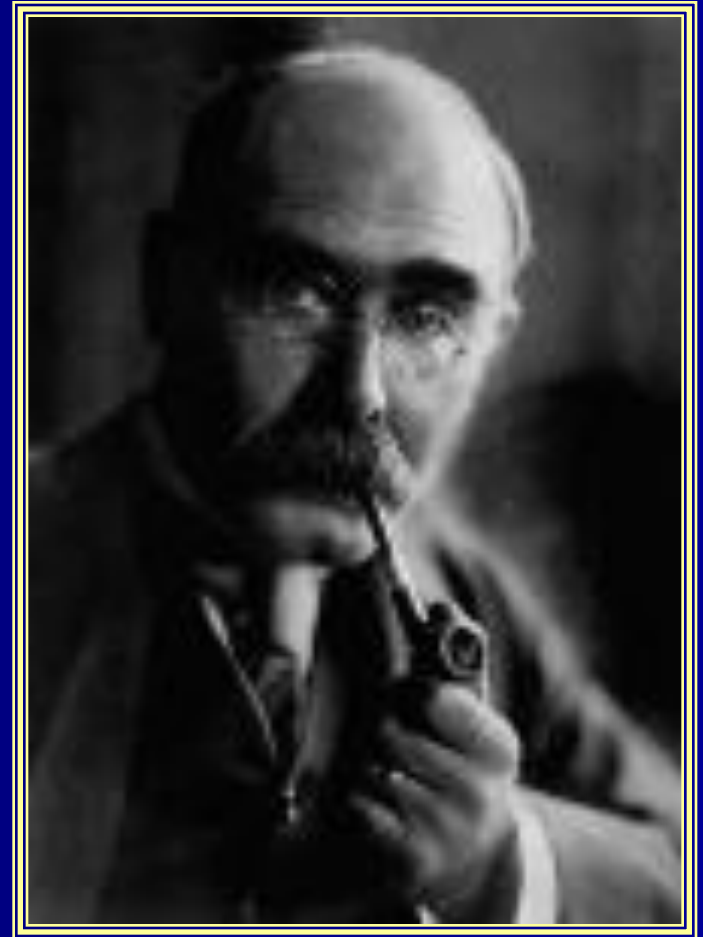
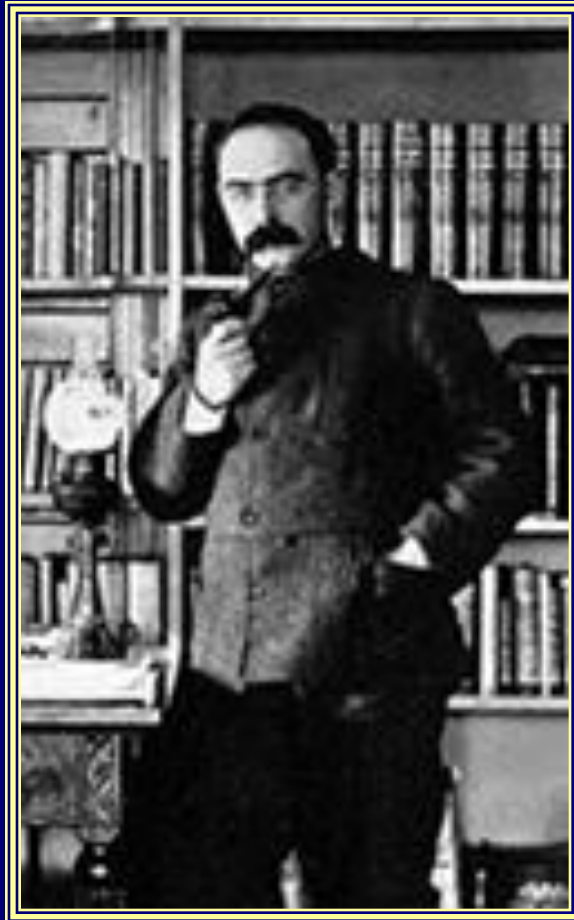

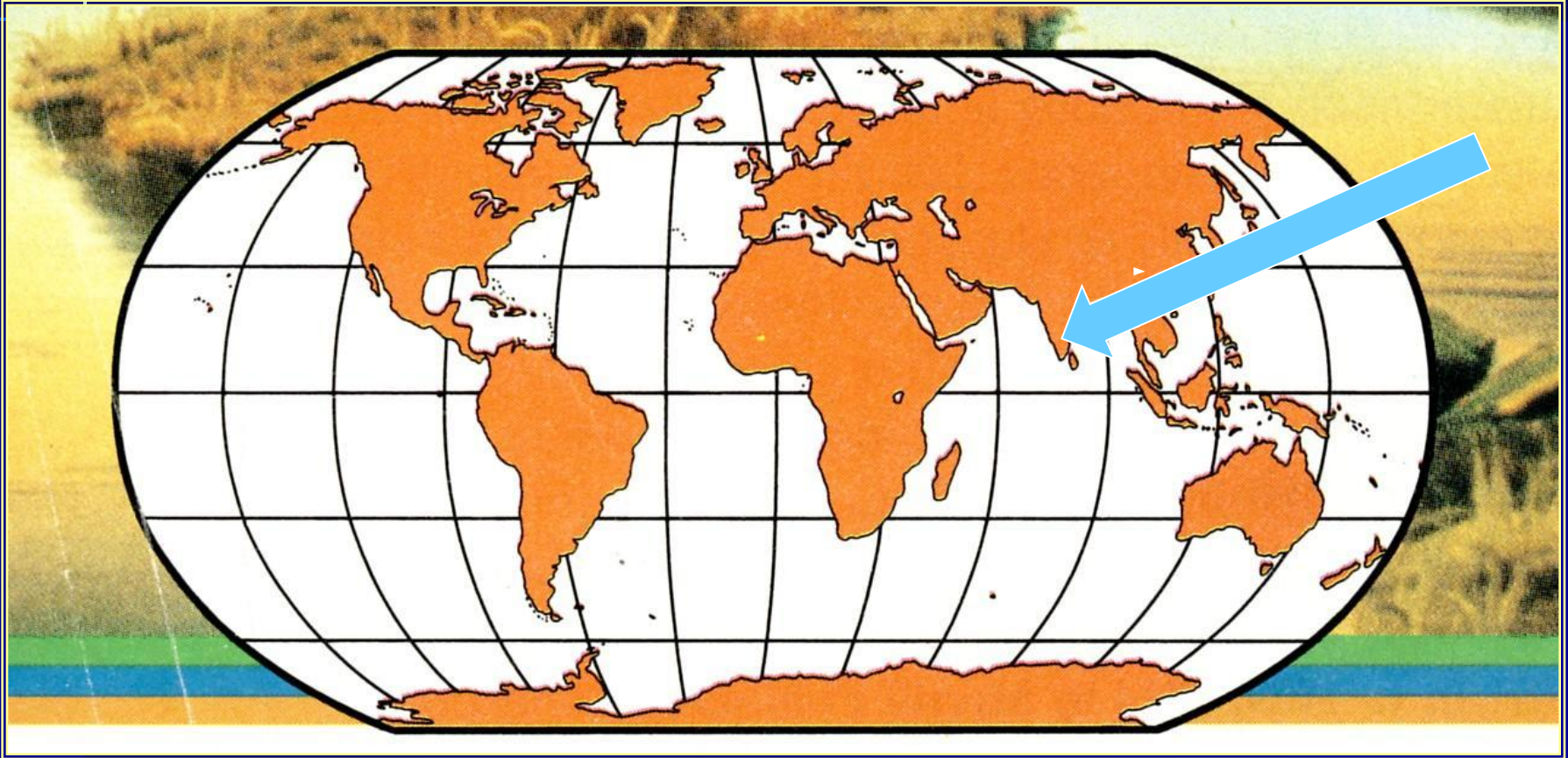
Rudyard Kipling  
(1865 – 1936)



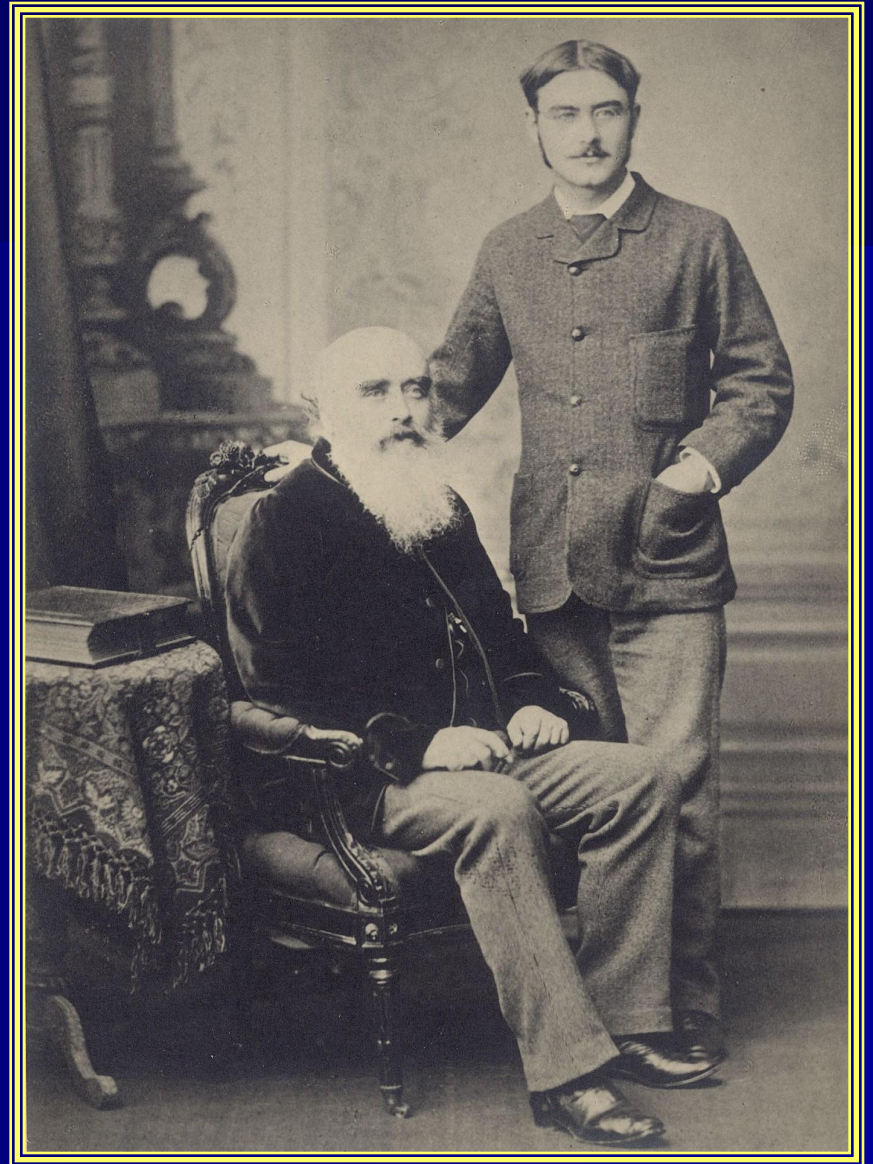
His books are known all over the world



He was born in India in 1865

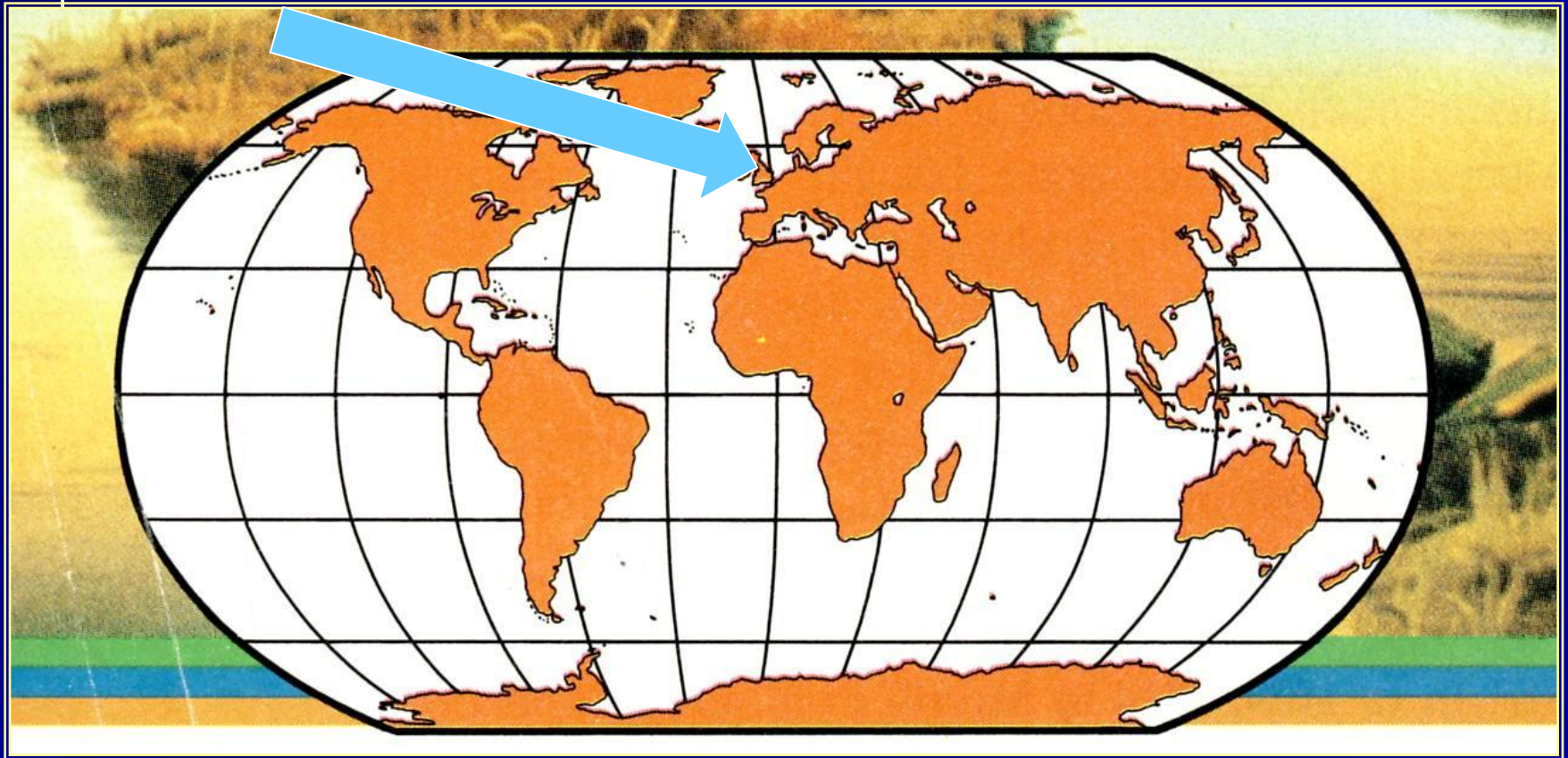


# Rudyard Kipling with his father





At the age of 6 he was sent to England

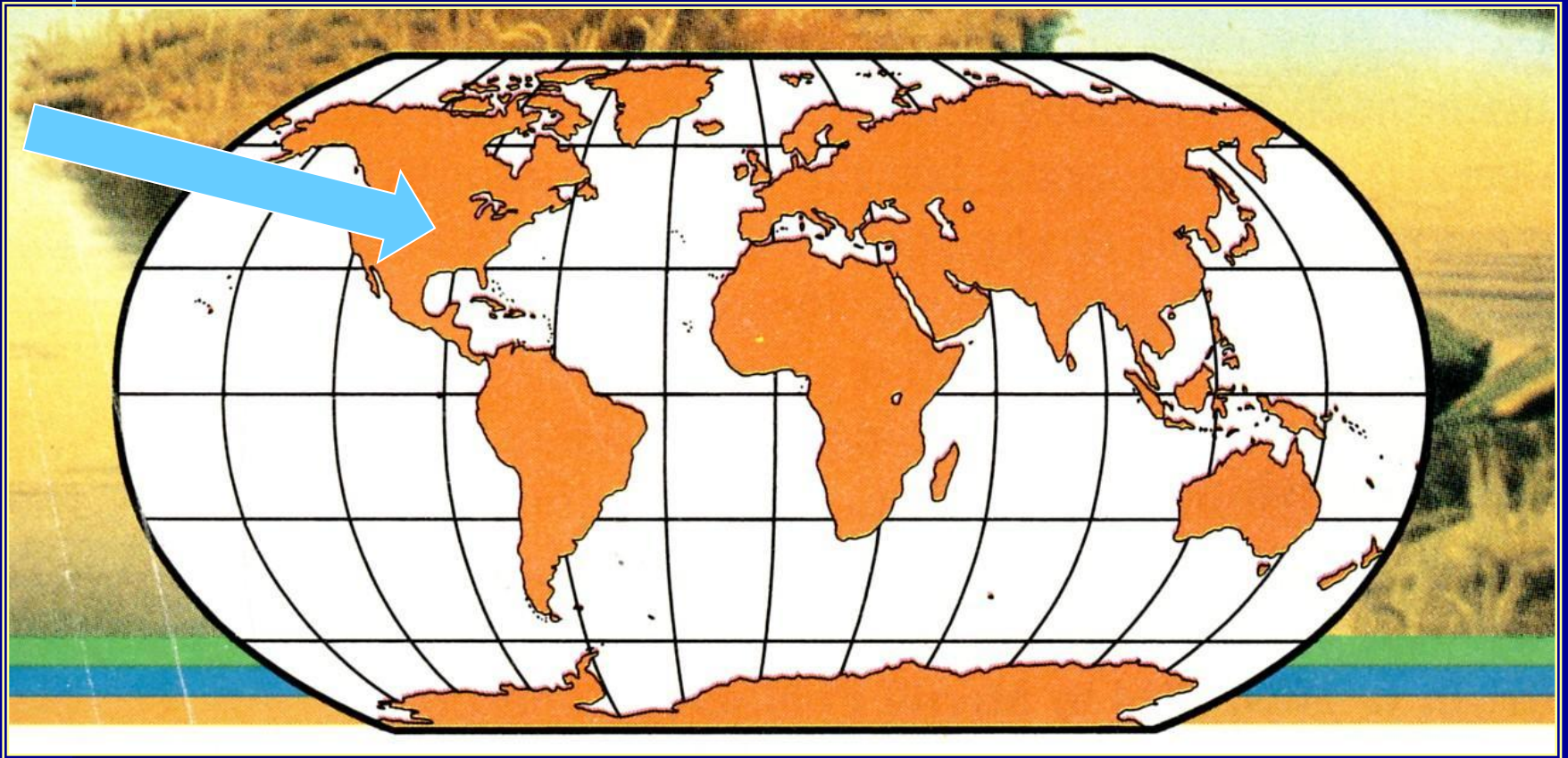


# Rudyard came back to India when he was 17 years old

and lived in America for some years

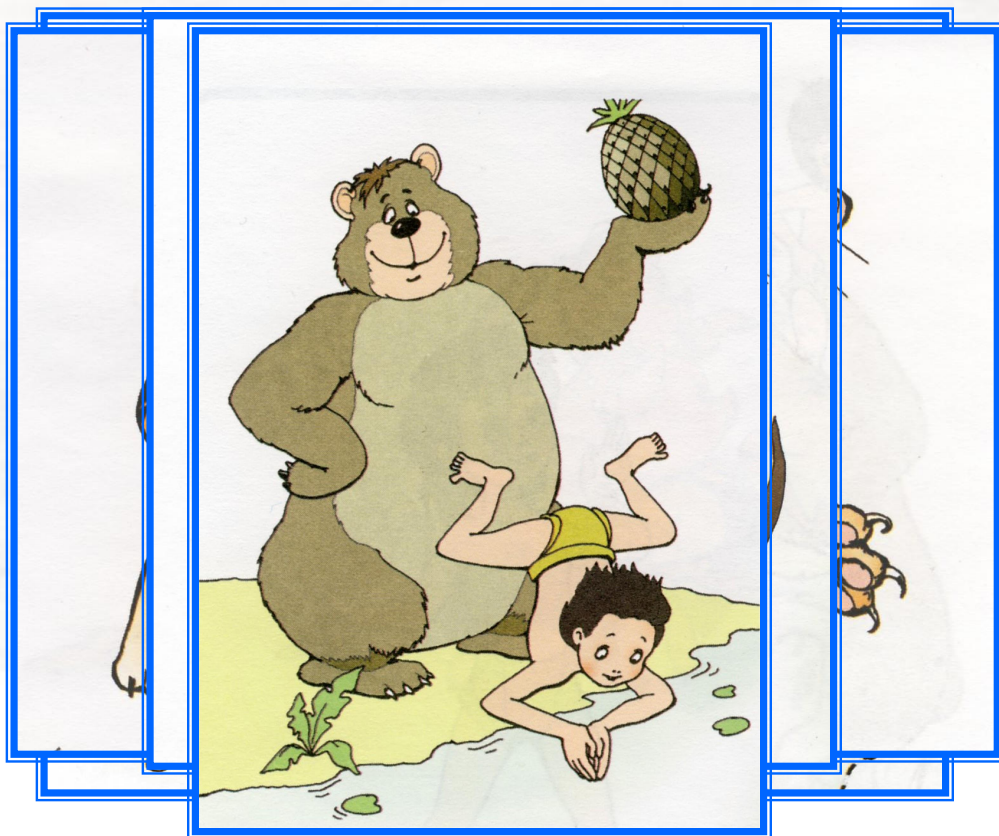

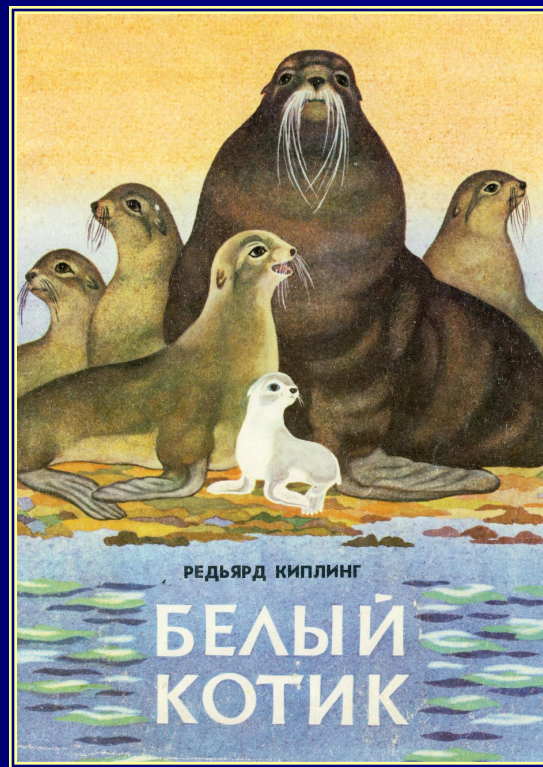
# The Elephant's Child

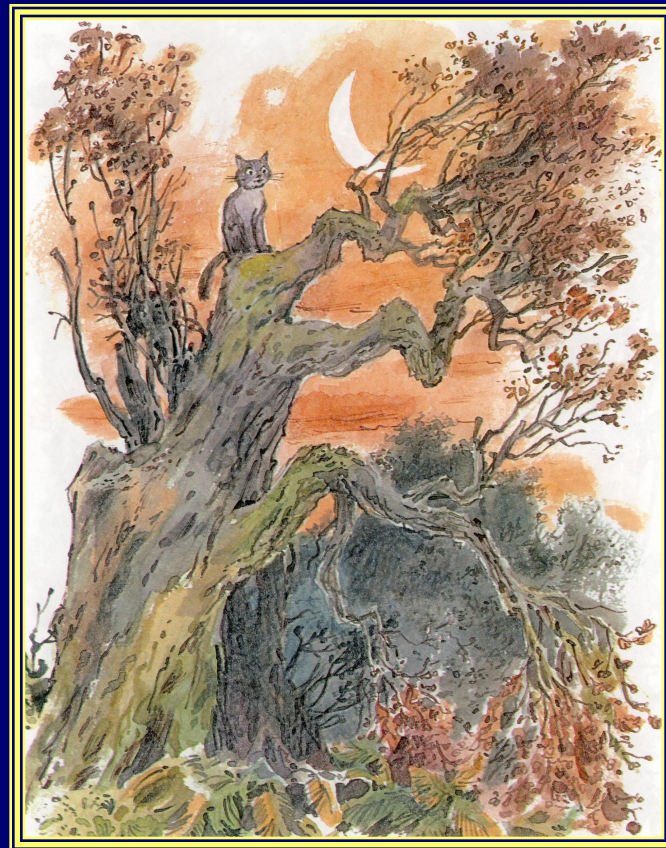

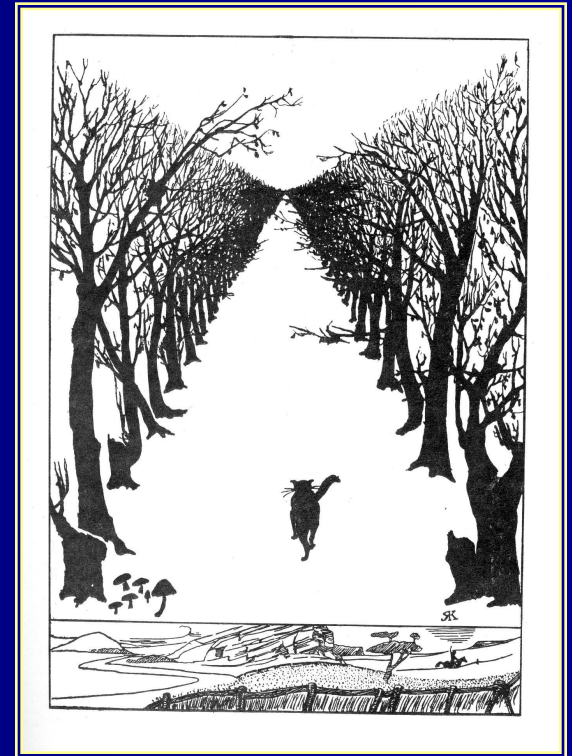
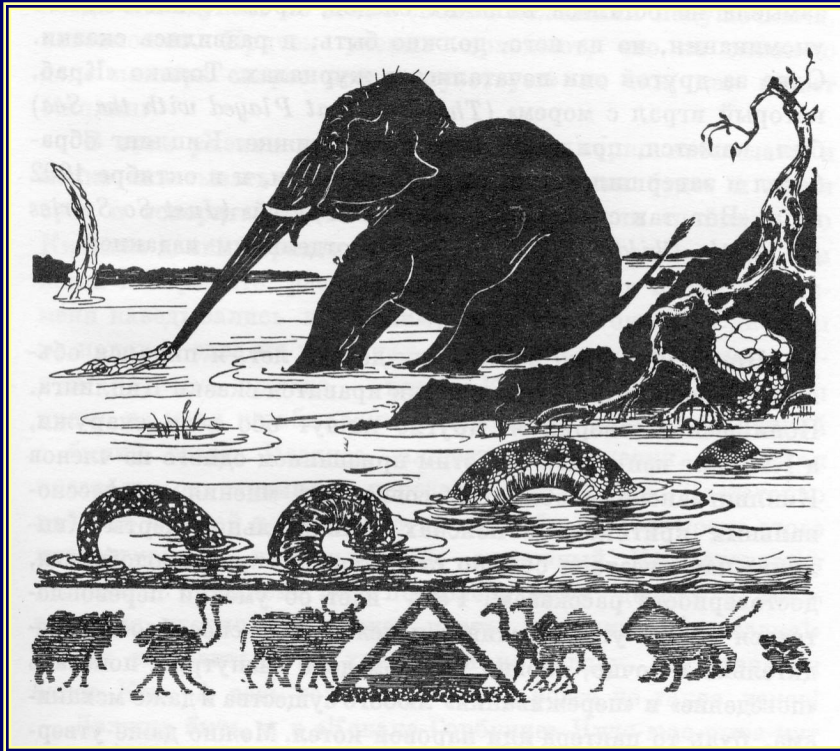




# The Cat that Walked by Himself

I give them all a rest.*

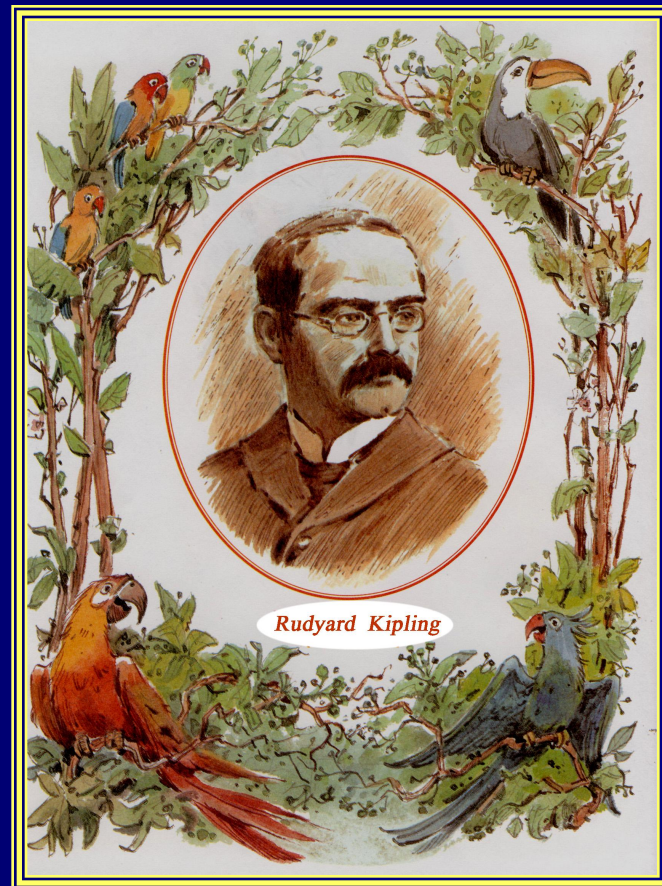
*I let them rest from nine till five,

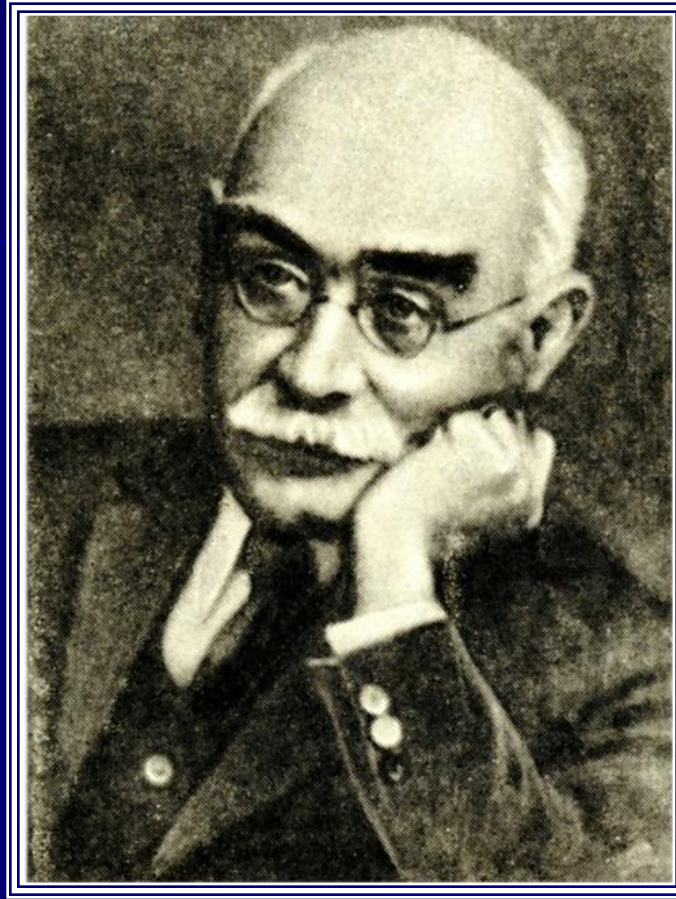
# Rudyard Kipling has written
