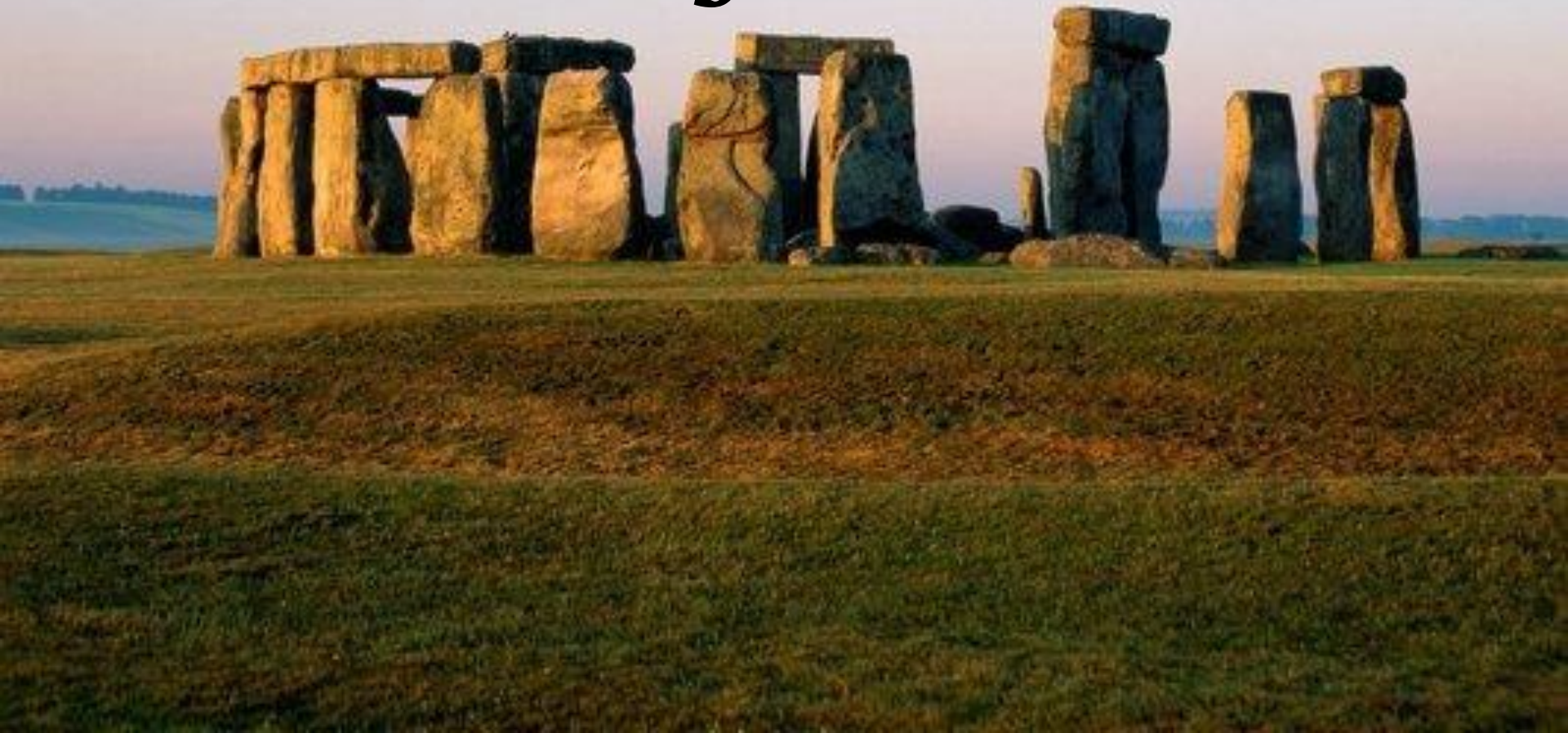

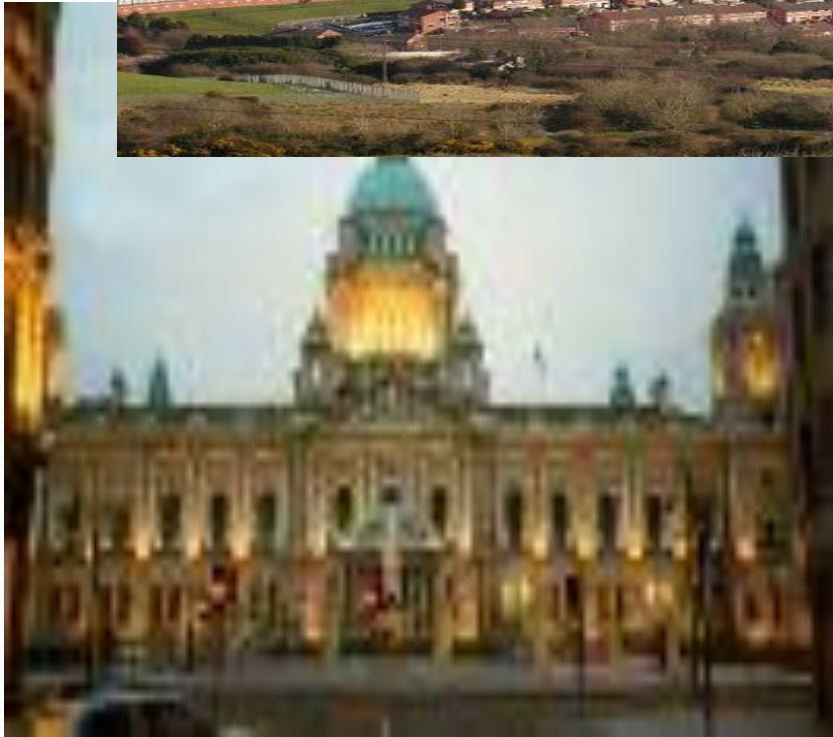
The capital of Scotland is **EDINBURGH**

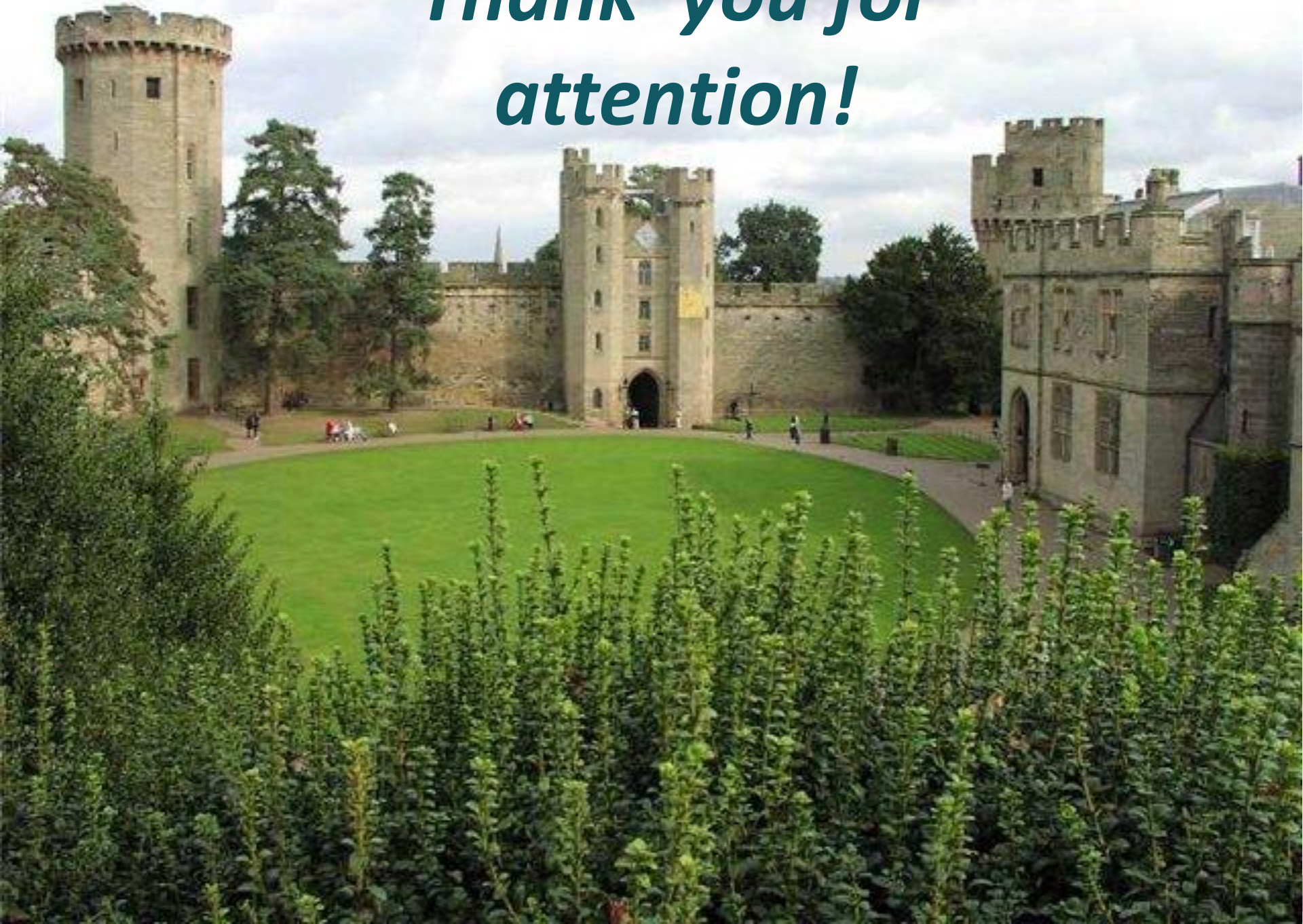
