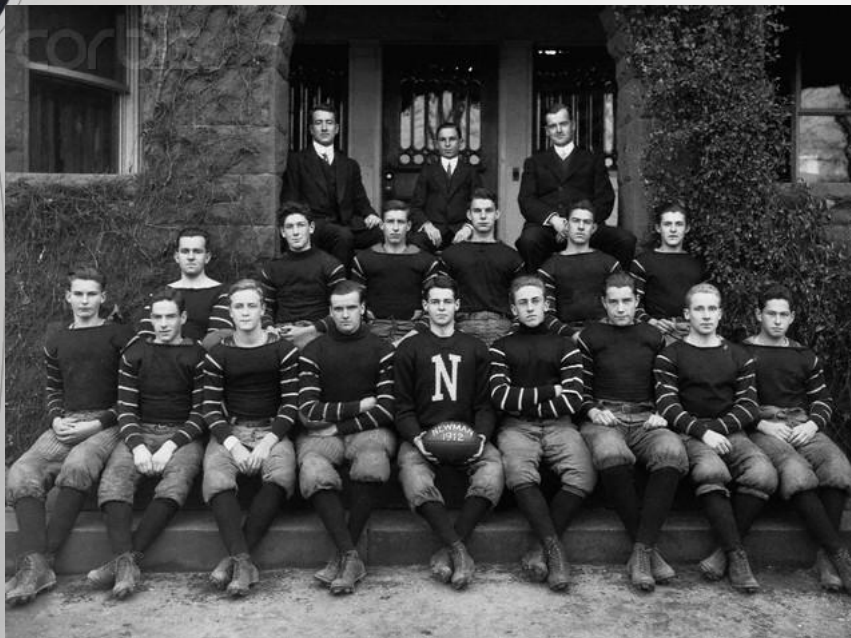
*The Major Events and Influences of the life of F. Scott Fitzgerald*

His father was a Southern gentleman whose persona he used to develop the character of Nick Carraway in the Great Gatsby.



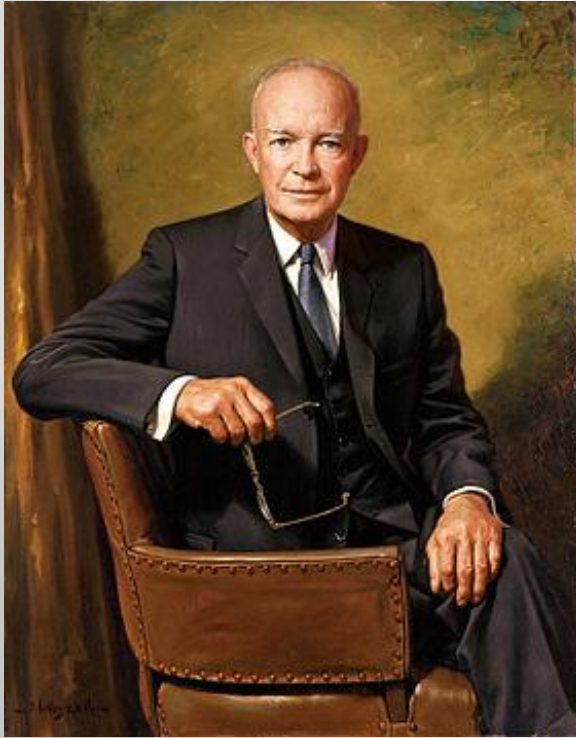


1911 Princeton football team

He joined the army.

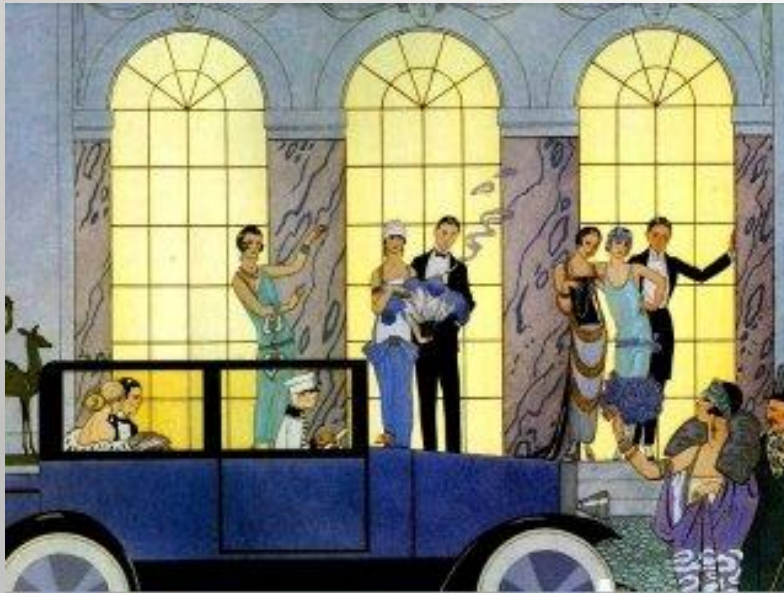
Captain of his training
