



About of the Astana city

1. "Abu Dhabi Plaza" - a multifunctional complex consisting of several buildings of different heights, under construction in Astana.


Construction began in November 2010 and should be completed in November 2016. After the construction of "Abu Dhabi Plaza" will be the tallest building in Kazakhstan and Central Asia. The peak of the tower will be located on the 88th floor - about 382 meters. The total area of "Abu Dhabi Plaza" will be more than 510 square meters. The estimated cost of more than \$ 1 billion. The complex will be located: a hotel, offices, residential apartments, a shopping center, a winter garden, and more. The complex will be connected direct monorail to the international airport of Astana.



2. "Emerald Towers" - a set of three high-rise towers of different heights (37, 40, 53 floors) in Astana. "Emerald Towers" is the tallest building in Kazakhstan. The tallest tower - 210 meters. Features of the building is asymmetrical, so starting with 32 floors floor area increases further, the last floor is rejected by 15 meters. The complex will occupy 280,000 square meters. m. The project cost is \$ 350 million.



"Khan Shatyr" - a major shopping and entertainment center in Astana. Opened July 6, 2010. Is the largest tent in the world. The original architecture of the center - the building is a giant transparent tent height of 150 m (spire), constructed from steel shrouds network on which the transparent polymer coating ETFE. Due to the special chemical composition, it protects the interior of the complex from the sharp temperature drops and creates a comfortable microclimate inside the complex ..

The total area of Khan Shatyr - 127 thousand square meters. The room housed retail trade and entertainment complexes. Including a supermarket, a family park, cafes and restaurants, cinemas, gyms, water park with an artificial beach and swimming pools with wave effect, service and office space, parking for 700 cars and more. The main highlight of Khan Shatyr - beach resort with a tropical climate, plants and the temperature of 35 degrees year round. The sandy beaches of the resort are equipped with heating, which creates a sense of the beach and the sand brought from the Maldives.

Architect is Norman Foster buildings.

The residential complex "Northern Lights" was erected in the center of Astana on Water-Green Boulevard in 2008. High-rise buildings, consisting of 34, 39 and 44 floors, similar to translate into reality the warm glow of the aurora borealis. The residential complex "Northern Lights" in the style of "high-tech". 39-storey building has a height of 152 meters.

Building Mazhilis (pictured left) is on the left bank in Astana, built it in 2004, the Turkish company "Ahse İnşaat". The total area of the four blocks of 26 800 square meters, is located close to the Majilis the President's residence, the building of the Supreme Court and the Senate. The building has 22 floors and 100 meters in height.
