The term <u>beatboxing</u> is derived from the mimicry of the first generation of drum machines, then known as beatboxes.






is a musical genre consisting of a stylized rhythmic music that commonly accompanies rapping, a rhythmic and rhyming speech that is chanted.

Djing is the art of manipulating sounds and creating music










Mcing – spoken or chanted rhyming lyrics with a strong rhythmic accompaniment




A **Disc Jockey (DJ)** is a person who selects and plays recorded music for an audience.
