


Country Profile: Kazakhstan


Geography

Government type: Unitary dominant-party presidential republic.


Independence from the Soviet Union declared on December 16, 1991 and finalized on December 26, 1991.

Languages: Kazakh (official state language) - 74% (understand spoken language); Russian (official) - 94.4% (understand spoken language) (2009 est.). Religions: Muslim (70.2%), Christian (26.2%) (mainly Russian Orthodox), other (0.2%), atheist (2.8%), unspecified (0.5%) (2009 est.). Education expenditures: 2.887% of GDP (2014 est.). Health expenditures: 4.4% of GDP (2014 est.).


Economic system: GDP per capita: \$24,300 (2015 est.) GDP - composition by sector:

Unemployment rate: 5% (2015 est.)

Industries: oil, coal, iron ore, manganese, chromite, lead, zinc, copper, titanium, bauxite, gold, silver, phosphates, sulfur, uranium, iron and steel; tractors and other agricultural machinery, electric motors, construction materials. Exports – commodities: oil and oil products (59%), ferrous metals (19%), chemicals (5%), machinery (3%), grain, wool, meat, coal.
