MADAME TUSSAUDS

 Madame Tussauds is the most famous wax museum. In 1835 Madame Tussaud established her first permanent exhibition inLondon's <u>Baker Street</u>.



 By the late 19th century most large cities had some kind of commercial wax museum, and for a century these remained highly popular. In the late 20th century it became harder for them to compete with other attractions.

 Madame Tussauds Hong Kong, part of the renowned chain of <u>wax museums</u>founded by <u>Marie Tussaud</u> of France, is located at the <u>Peak Tower</u> on <u>Hong Kong Island</u> in Hong Kong

- Today, this new branch of Madame Tussauds focuses almost exclusively on Hollywood stars, as befits its new location.
