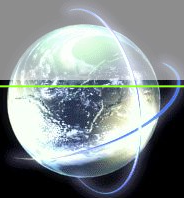

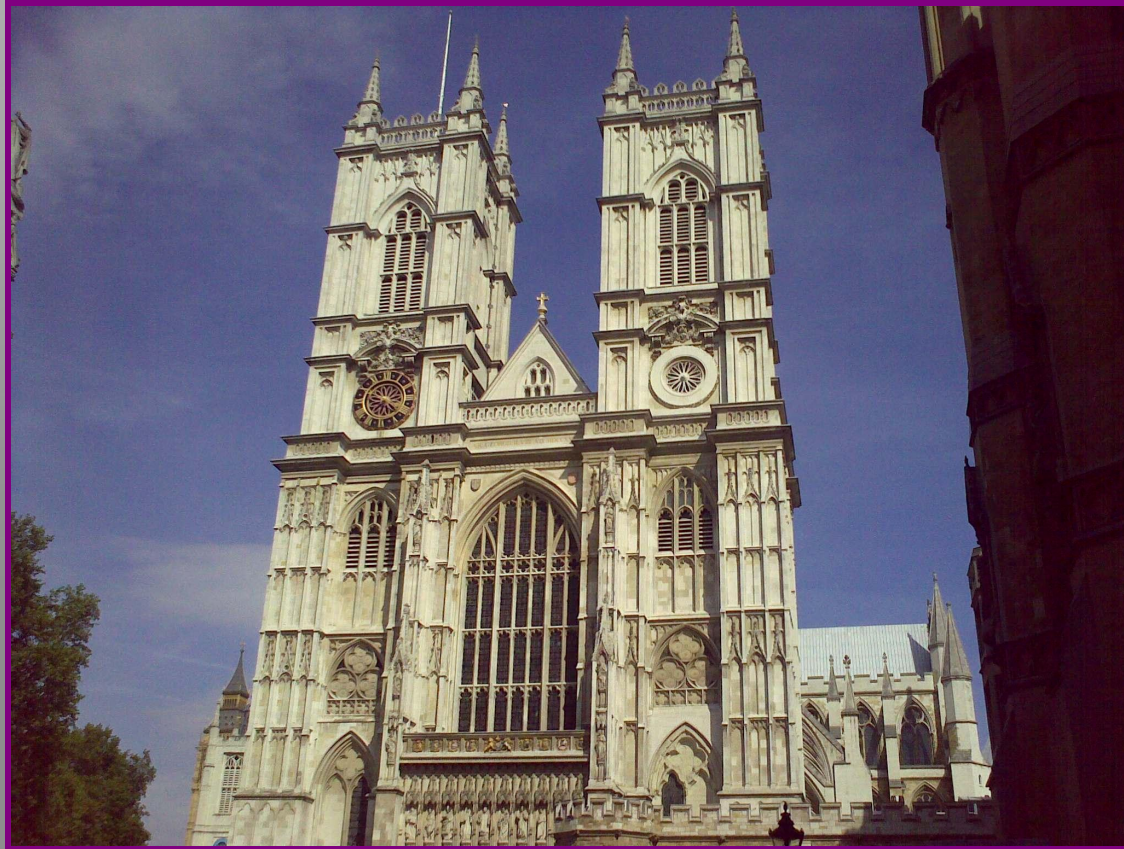


# The Trafalgar Square

# A telephone box



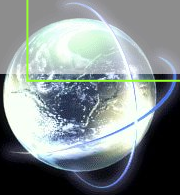
# A telephone box

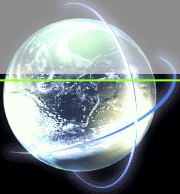

# A trip to UK

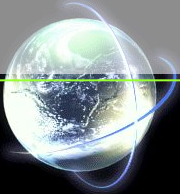

# A trip to UK

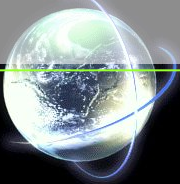
The population of the UK is about 60 million people. A lot nationalities live in the UK.
