There are many monuments of the First World War in Russia. They are situated in different cities of our country.



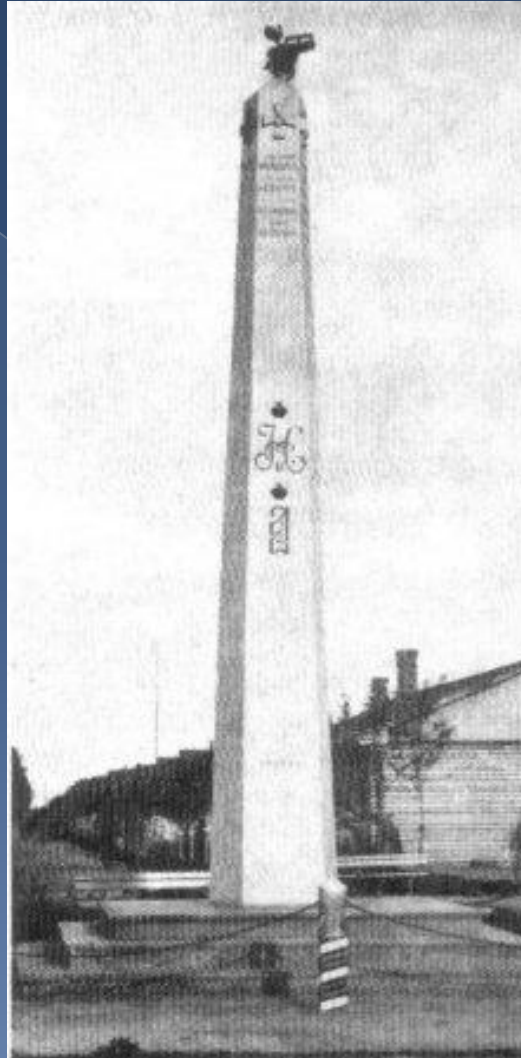
One of them is Monument to the heroes of World War I in Moscow. It was opened in 2014. It is situated on Poklonnaya Hill.

The main Russian monument of the First World War in Vyazma was opened in 1916, even before the end of the war. It has not been restored yet.
