It was established in 1872 as the world's first truly national park.

Over 1,700 species of trees and other plants are native to the park.



Yellowstone National Park



There are almost 60 species of mammals in the park, including the gray wolf, the lynx, grizzly bears, the bison (buffalo), black bear, moose, deer, mountain goat and mountain lion.

The Lake District, also known as The Lakes or Lakeland, is a mountainous region in North West England. As a popular holiday destination, it is famous for its lakes, forests and mountains.



It is the largest National Park in the country (885 sq. miles) and is considered one of its most scenic regions and England's best destination for hiking and climbing. The Lake District comprises 16 lakes. The lakes and rivers are cool and mainly unpolluted.



Windermere is the largest natural lake in England which is situated in the county of Cumbria, in Lake District National Park. It is a ribbon lake. The lake contains 18 islands.



Scafell Pike is the highest mountain in England. It is 978 metres above sea level. It is located in Lake District National Park, Cumbria.



The Lake District is home to a range of bird and fish species. Charr, crayfish, schelly and vendace are found in different lakes.

It has the largest population of red squirrels in England. There are 140,000 of them in the United Kingdom.
