The biggest lakes are Taupo and Haruoko.





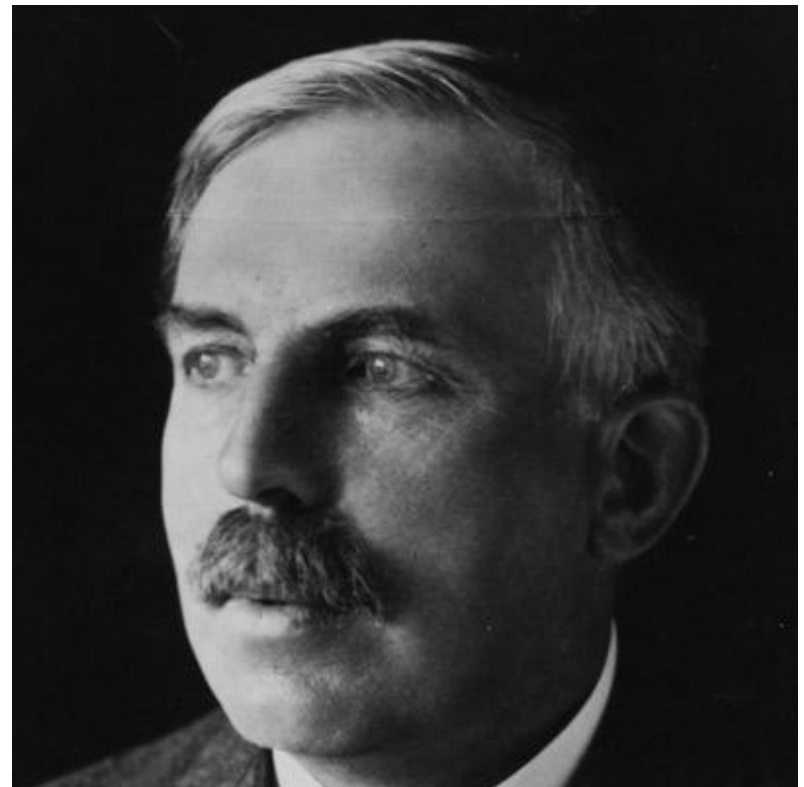
# Mountains
