




MOSCOW

BURJ KHALIFA

Burj Khalifa, known as Burj Dubai before its inauguration, is a skyscraper in Dubai. It is the tallest man-made structure in the world, standing at 829.8 m







































The perfect place to get up to speed with the history and culture of the emirate. The museum occupies the old Al Fahidi Fort. Dating from around 1800, the fort is the oldest building in Dubai, having originally been built to defend the town's landward approaches against raids by rival Bedouin tribes.





Old Dubai is recently renovated conservation area. Sand-coloured stone houses line the narrow lanes and open up onto shady courtyards.



The Arbat has existed since at least the 15th century, thus laying claim to being one of the oldest surviving streets of the Russian capital. It forms the heart of the Arbat District of Moscow. Originally the street formed part of an important trade route and was home to a large number of craftsmen.
