- It is responsible for administrating, funding, and marketing public transport

- You can use the **same tickets on all public transport** in Oslo: bus, tram, metro, train and ferry



- Ticket machine

Single ticket pre-bought

(free transfer/return within 1 hour)

Adult 33 NOK

Child/senior 17 NOK

Single ticket, bought from driver

(free transfer/return within 1 hour)

Adult 55 NOK

Child/senior 28 NOK

24-hour ticket

(flexible start time, non-personal ticket)

Adult 90 NOK

Child/senior 45 NOK

7-day ticket

(flexible start date, non-personal ticket)

Adult 240 NOK

Child/youth/senior 120 NOK

30-day ticket

(flexible start date, non-personal ticket)

Adult 708 NOK

Child/youth/senior 354 NOK

Student 425 NOK (with Norwegian student card and semester card)

365-day ticket

(flexible start date)

Adult 7080 NOK

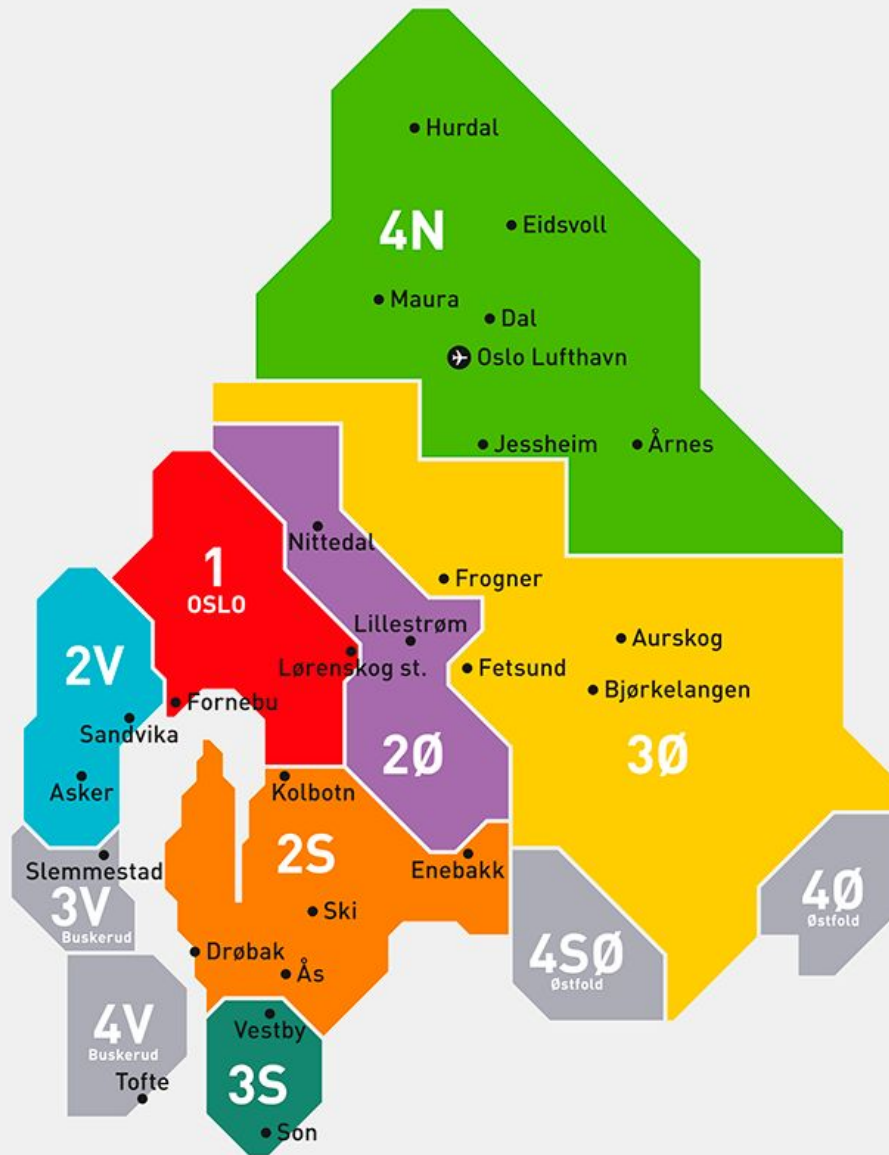

- Oslo Pass - unlimited free travel by bus, tram, underground, boat and local train

- Between 1 am and 4 am
Saturdays and Sundays
- Zones 1 and 2

Boats/ferries



- The airport is located outside zone 2
- Flytoget (airport express train) or Flybussen is not included in the Oslo Pass
