(FOR TIME)

• AT for a precise time

- at three o'clock
- at noon
- at the moment
- IN for months, years, centuries and long periods
- in May
- in summer
- in 2002

• ON for days and dates

- on Sunday
- on my birthday
- on New Year's Eve

### EXPRESSIONS WITH AT/IN/ON (FOR TIME)

• AT the weekend

AT Christmas

• AT night

AT Christmas

AT the same time

• AT present

IN the morning

IN the afternoon

IN the evening

**ON** Tuesday morning

**ON** Saturday mornings

**ON** Sunday afternoons

**ON** Monday evening

# Don't use AT/IN /ON with LAST/NEXT/EVERY/THIS

- We went to Saaremaa last May.
- We paint eggs every Easter.
- He's coming home next Sunday.
- I'll call you this evening.

- not in last May
- not at every Easter
- not on pext Sunday
- not in this evening
