# Reported Speech

## Sequence of Tenses

- Если главное предложение стоит в Past Simple и действие придаточного предложения происходит:
  - 1) одновременно с действием в главном предложении
    - Present Simple  $\Rightarrow$  Past Simple
    - Present Progressive  $\Rightarrow$  Past Progressive
  - 2) предшествует действию в главном предложении
    - Present Perfect  $\Rightarrow$  Past Perfect
    - Past Simple  $\Rightarrow$  Past Perfect
  - 3) позже действия главного
    - Future Simple  $\Rightarrow$  Future-in-the-Past






## Reported Speech

- this– that, these – those
- here – there, now – then
- today – that day, yesterday – the day before
- tomorrow – (the) next day/the following day
- ago – before, earlier
- last week/year – the week/year before
- the next week/year – the following week/  
year
