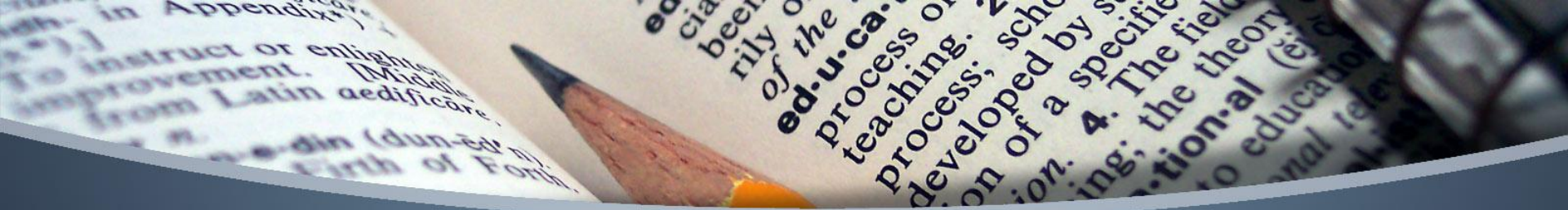
A Few Facts About Scotland
