In France there are a set of language schools offering courses of the French language as foreign , especially adapted for foreign students

Advantages:

- ❖ Studying at the state universities of France is free-of-charge.
- ❖ There are courses of the French language adapted for foreign students

Disadvantage:

- ❖ The cost is much more expensive but the variety of services included in it is less than in Canada.

STUDYING IN GERMANY

In high educational institutions of Germany successful students of the West-European schools are accepted . For the Russian student it is necessary to finish 2 courses of day time branch of the Russian institute or 1 course of the Institute and preparatory branch of German University

Peculiarities of German HIGH SCHOOLS

- **Entrance examinations do not exist.**
- **Foreigners only pass the exam to check German & it is possible to be prepared for it being a student there**
- **Age restrictions and restrictions of the marital status.**
- **Students in Germany have possibility to work, are provided with a hostel, use huge quantity of privileges and discounts.**

Studying In Russia

For foreigners it is necessary to pass test on Russian or a course of Russian for entering

Advantages:

Disadvantages:

- ❑ Additional payment for residing , language courses
- ❑ You have to work to support yourself
- ❑ Russian diploma is quoted in some countries

Disadvantages:

- ✓ High cost of studying
- ✓ Restriction for work while studying
- ✓ Narrow range of included services in price
- ✓ High level of English is required
- ✓ Russian students have no opportunities to enter the University directly after finishing school

Advantages:

- No privileges to children of high-ranking parents
- High level of education
- Strict discipline

STUDYING IN AMERICA

The educational system of the USA has no equal on breadth of a choice of educational institutions, conditions of training, education programs and subjects specialization.

Public College	1)Students of such colleges frequently are night-school students who work within a day. 2)Many of these schools offer special services for the international students 3)Free-of-charge studying 4)Many of public colleges also offer intensive programs of studying English

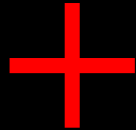

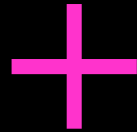
Cultural Exchange



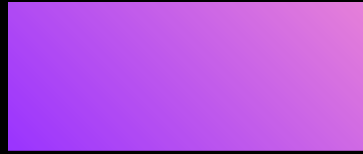
- Operates in many advanced countries

- ❑ Opportunity to pass a preparatory intensive course of English (they are paid)

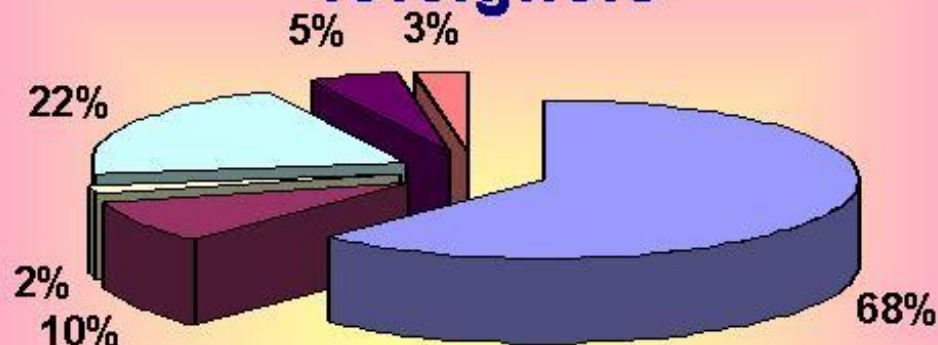

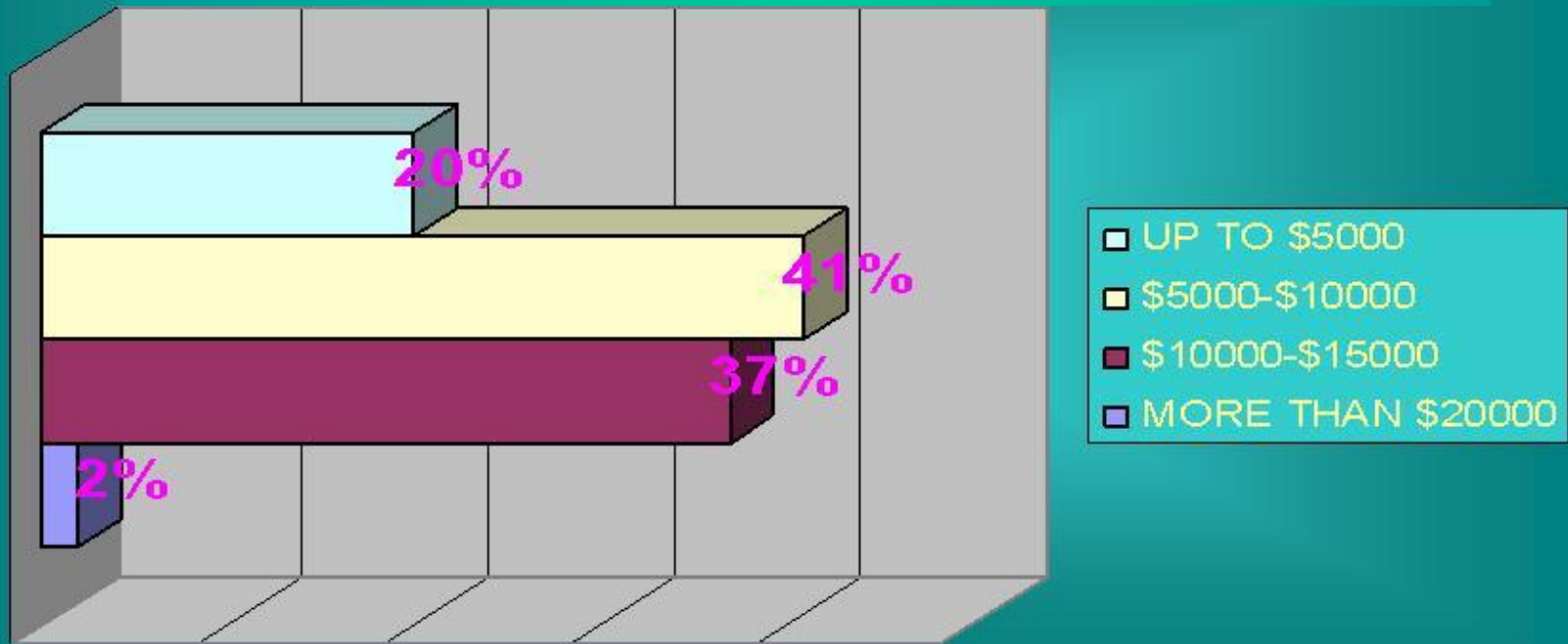

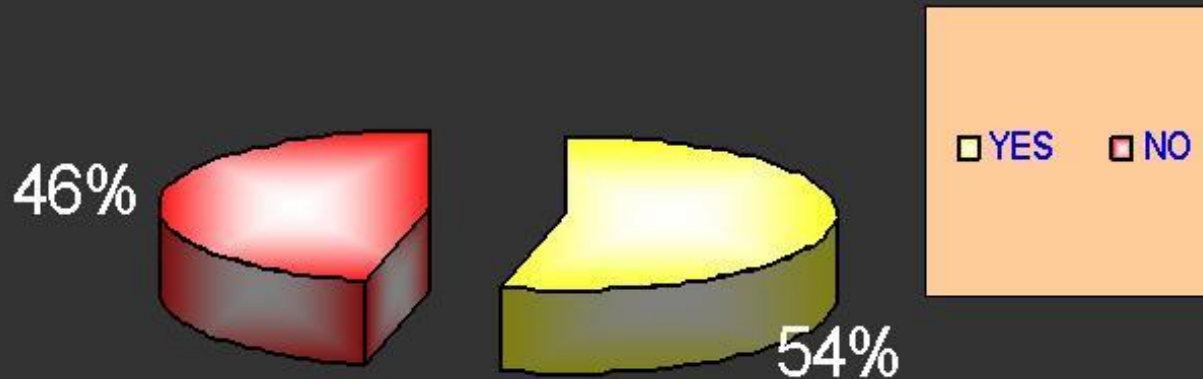
Having analyzed the number of foreign students involved in different educational programs we made this circuit.

HOW MANY STUDENTS WANT TO STUDY ABROAD



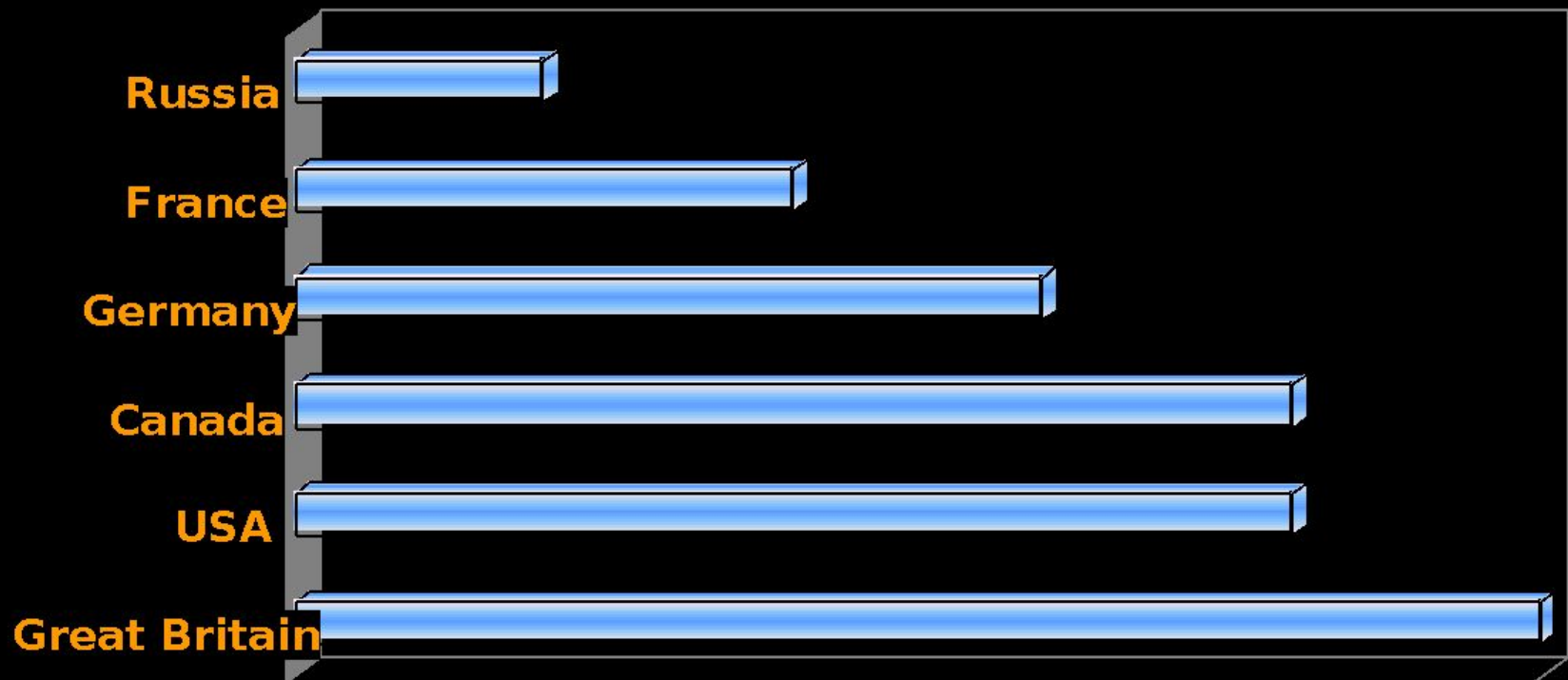
