

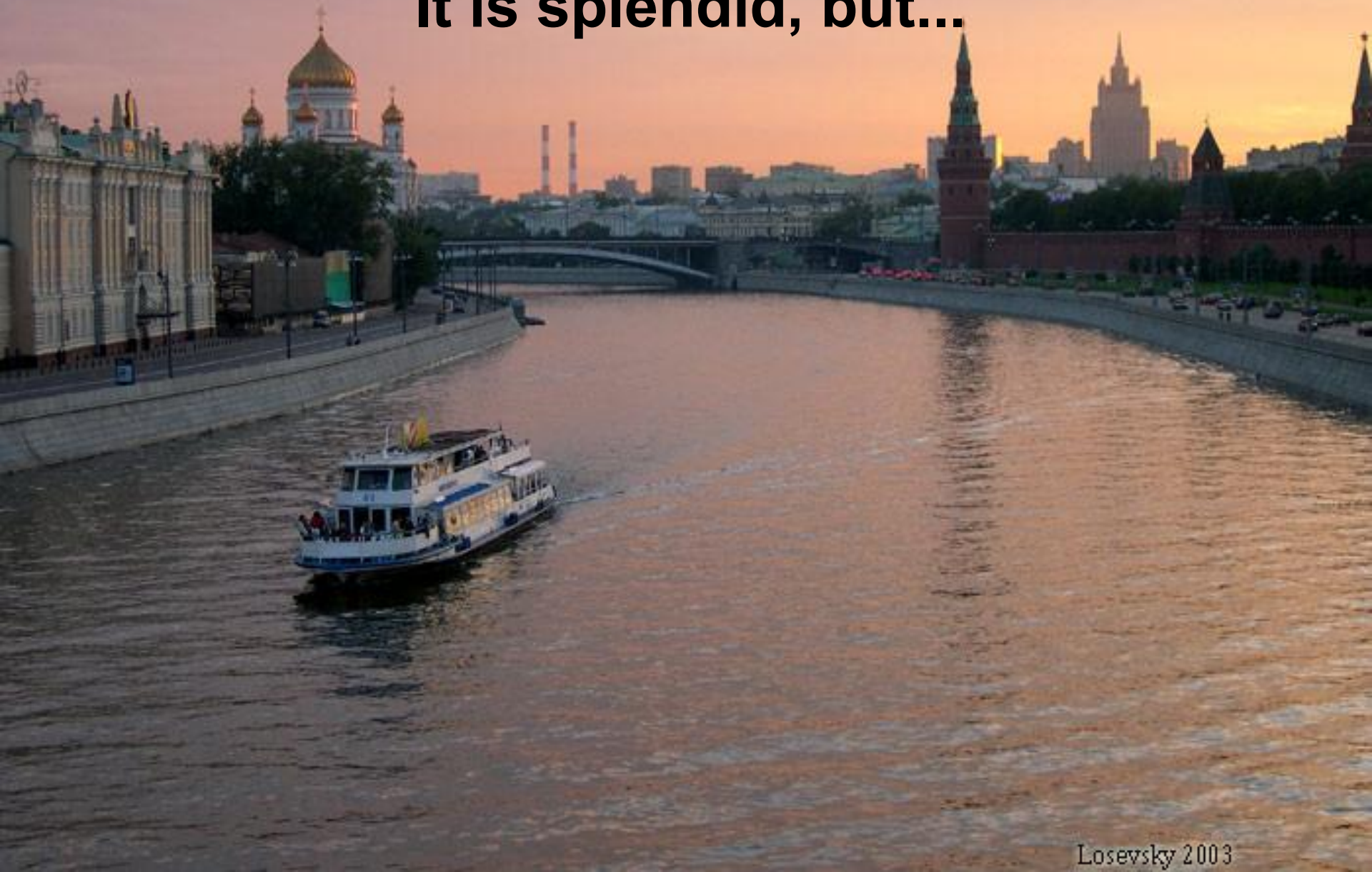

Moscow is the first city of our travelling



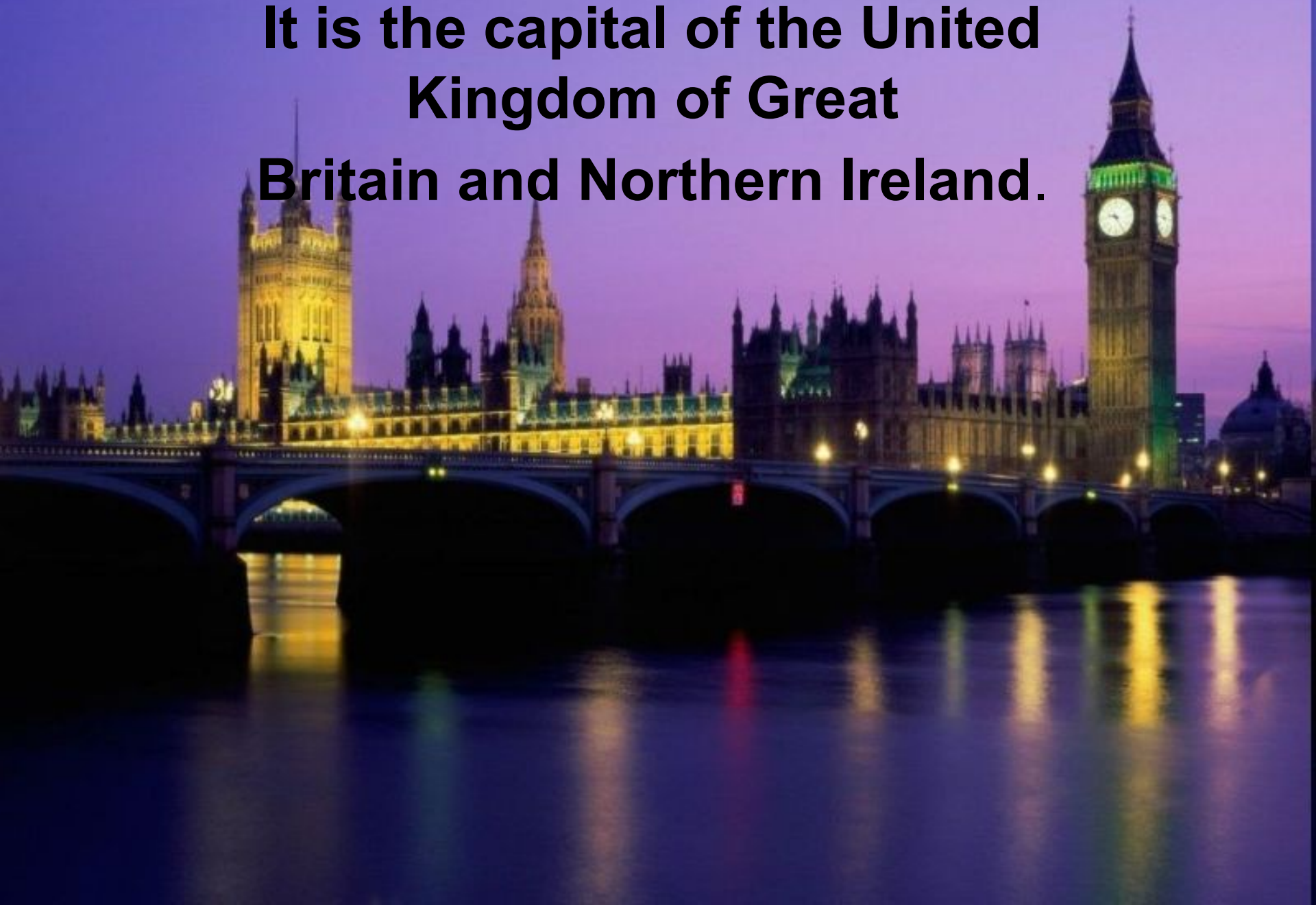
It is splendid, but...

Sidney Opera House is one of the greatest examples of the 20th Century architecture. It is a symbol of Sydney.



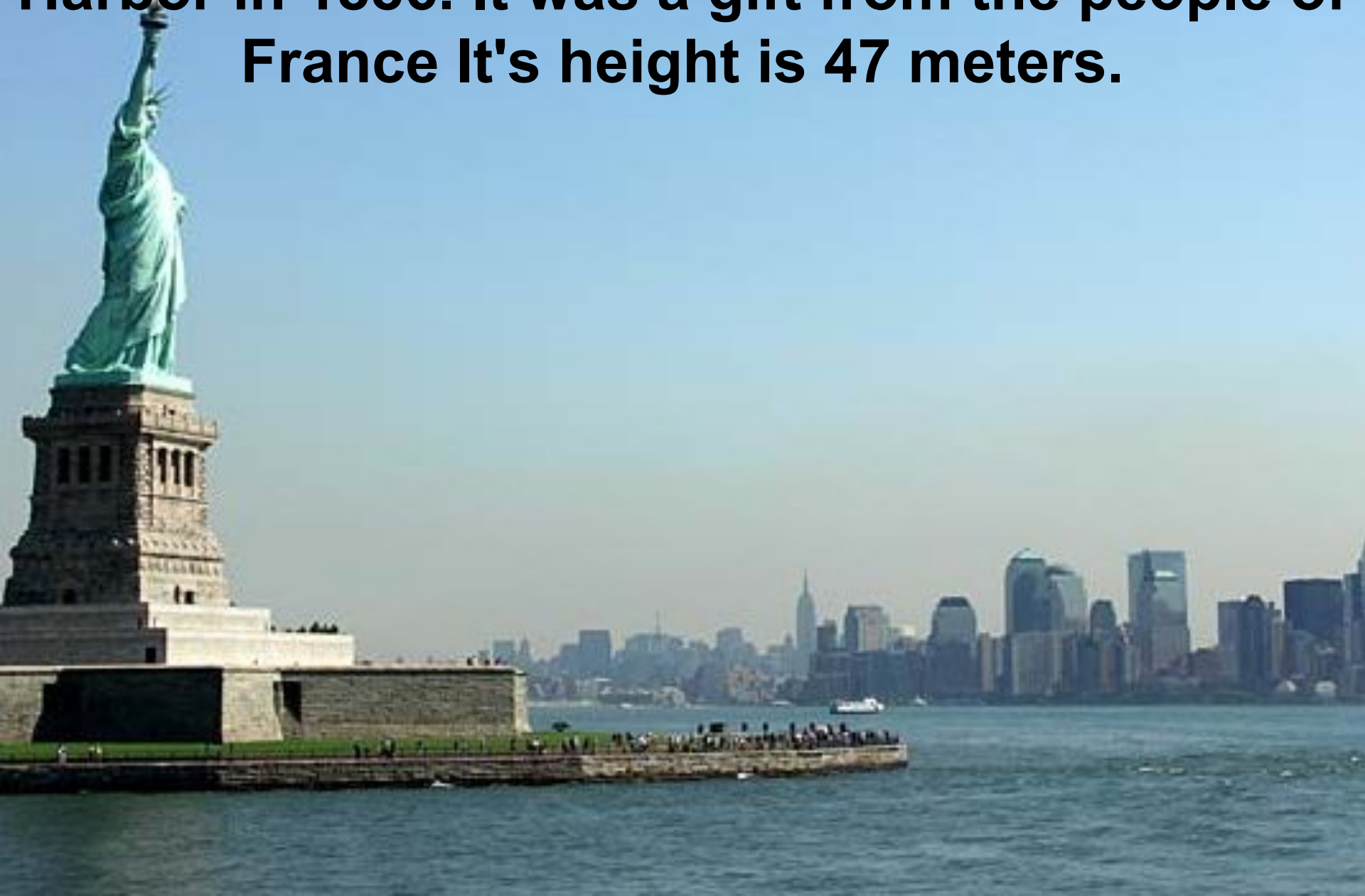

Russia.**

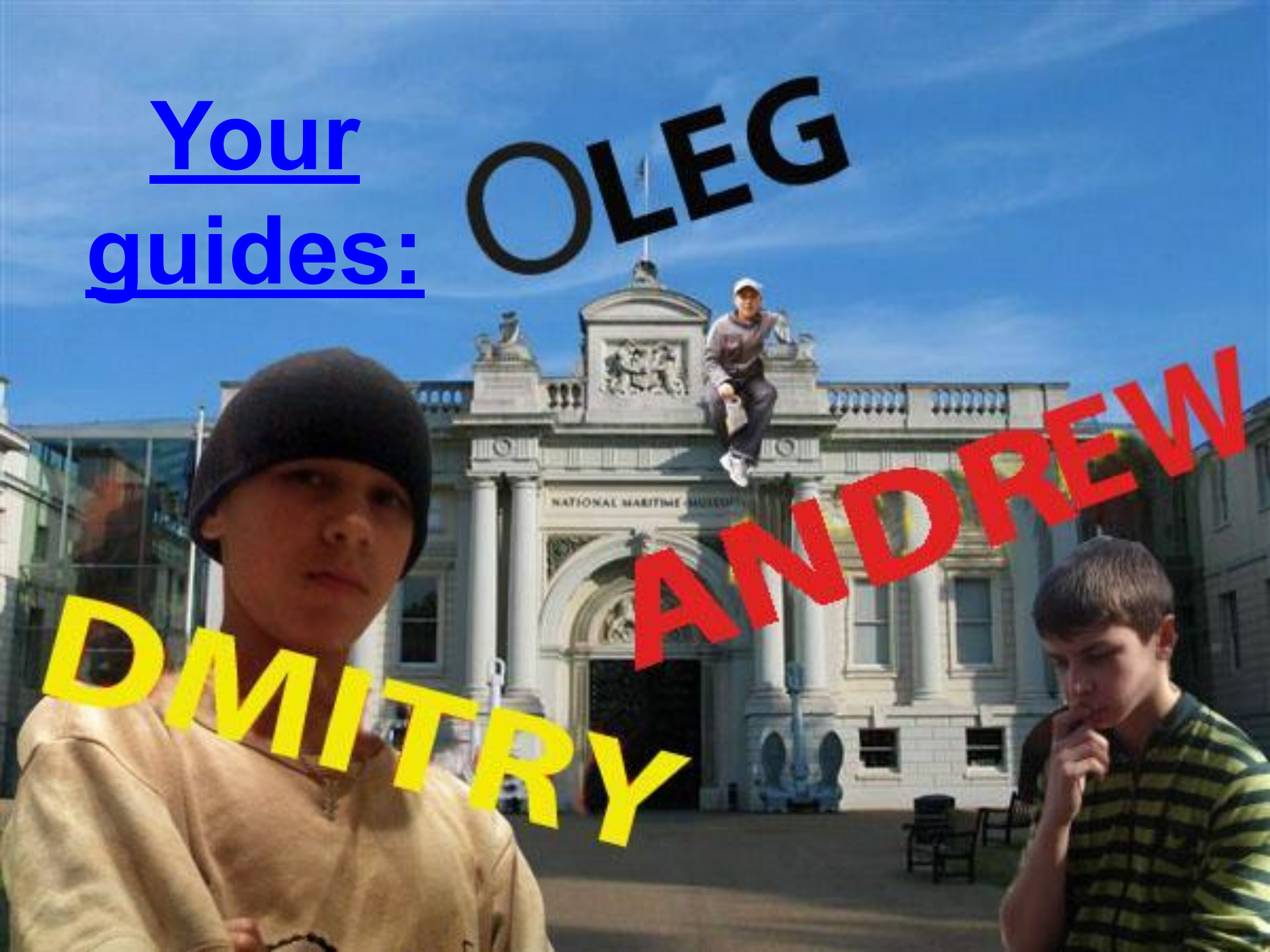
