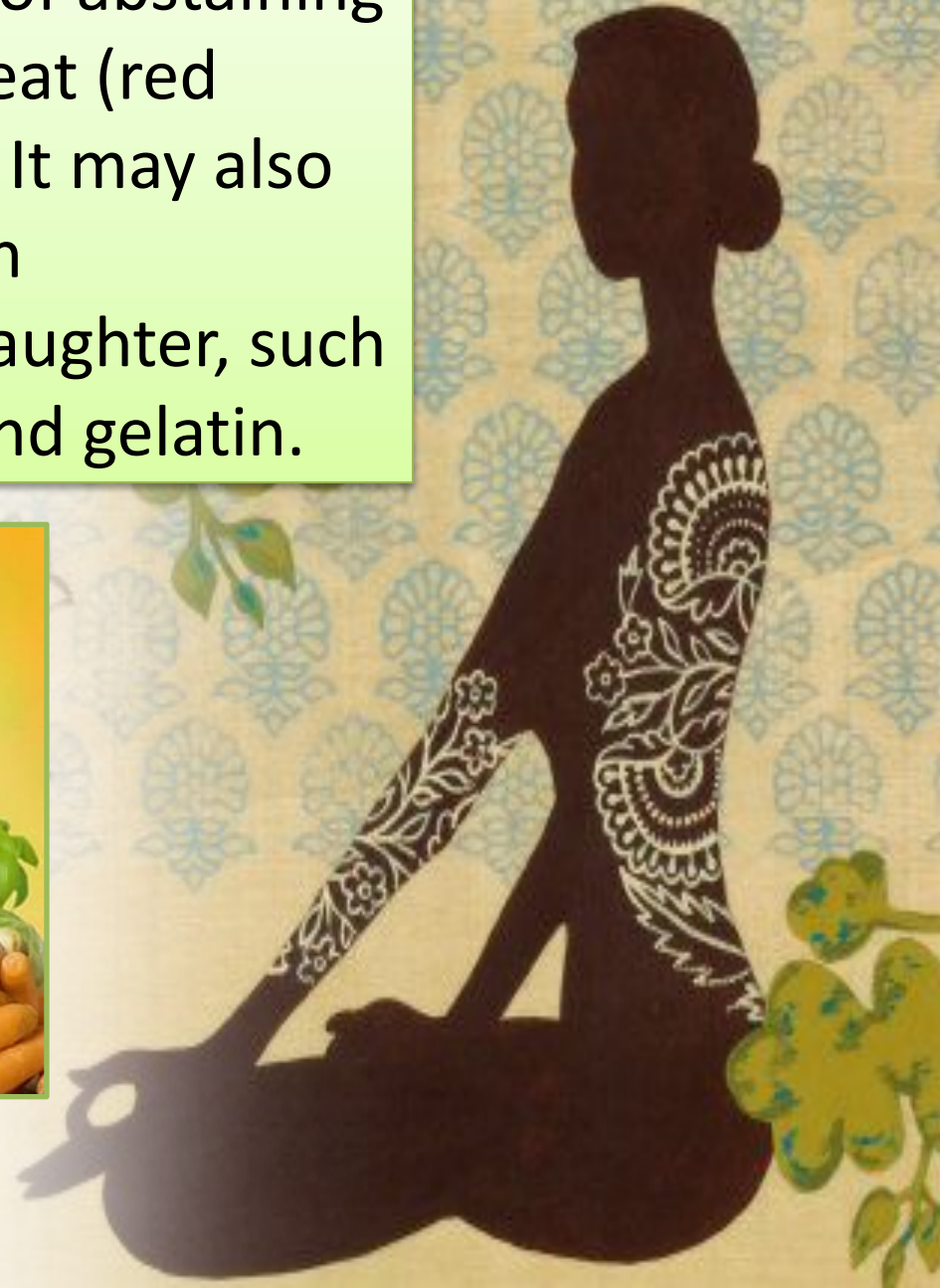


# Vegetarianism

meat or no meat?

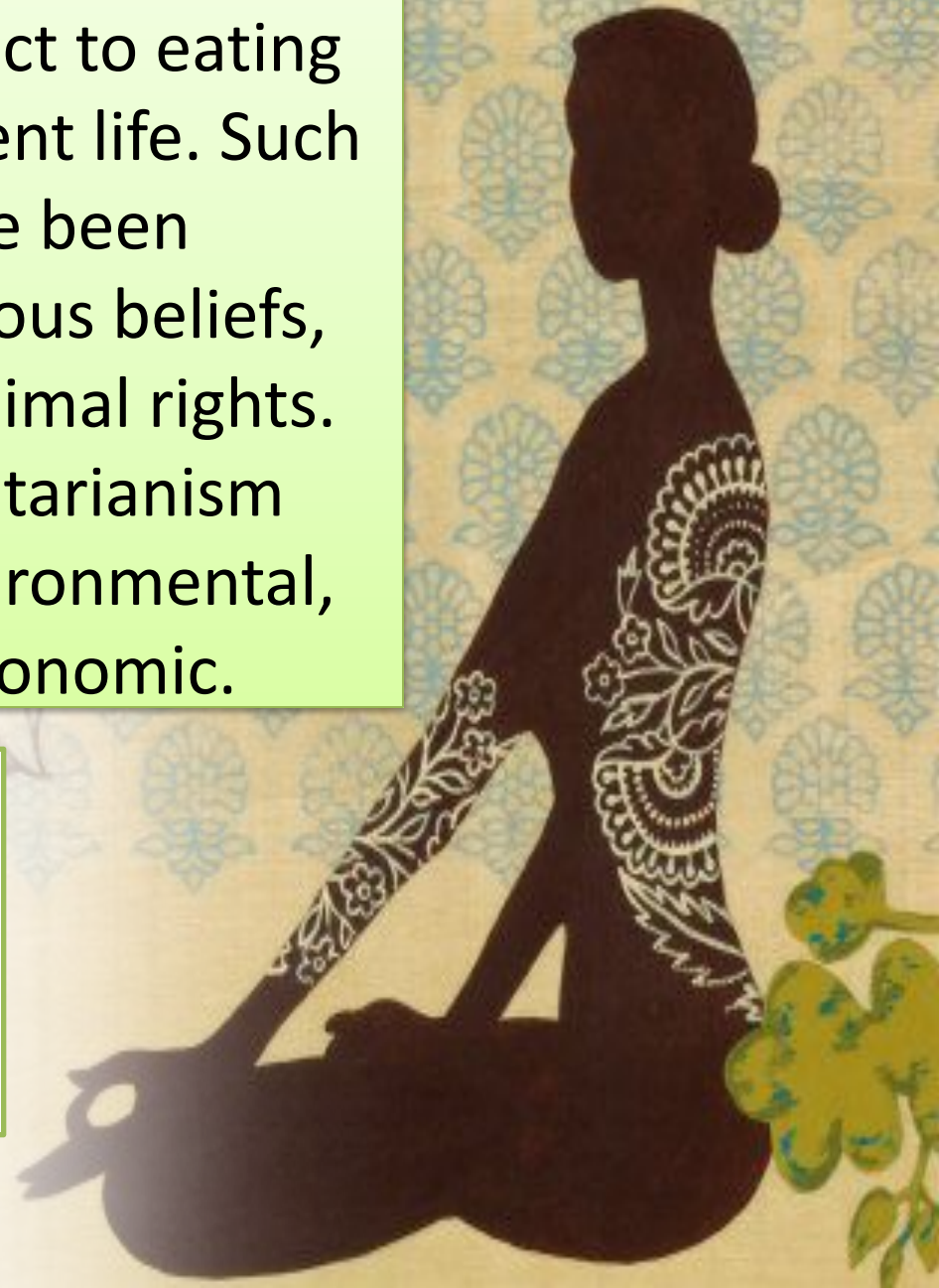
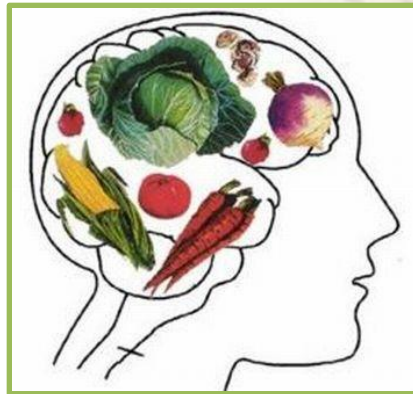
