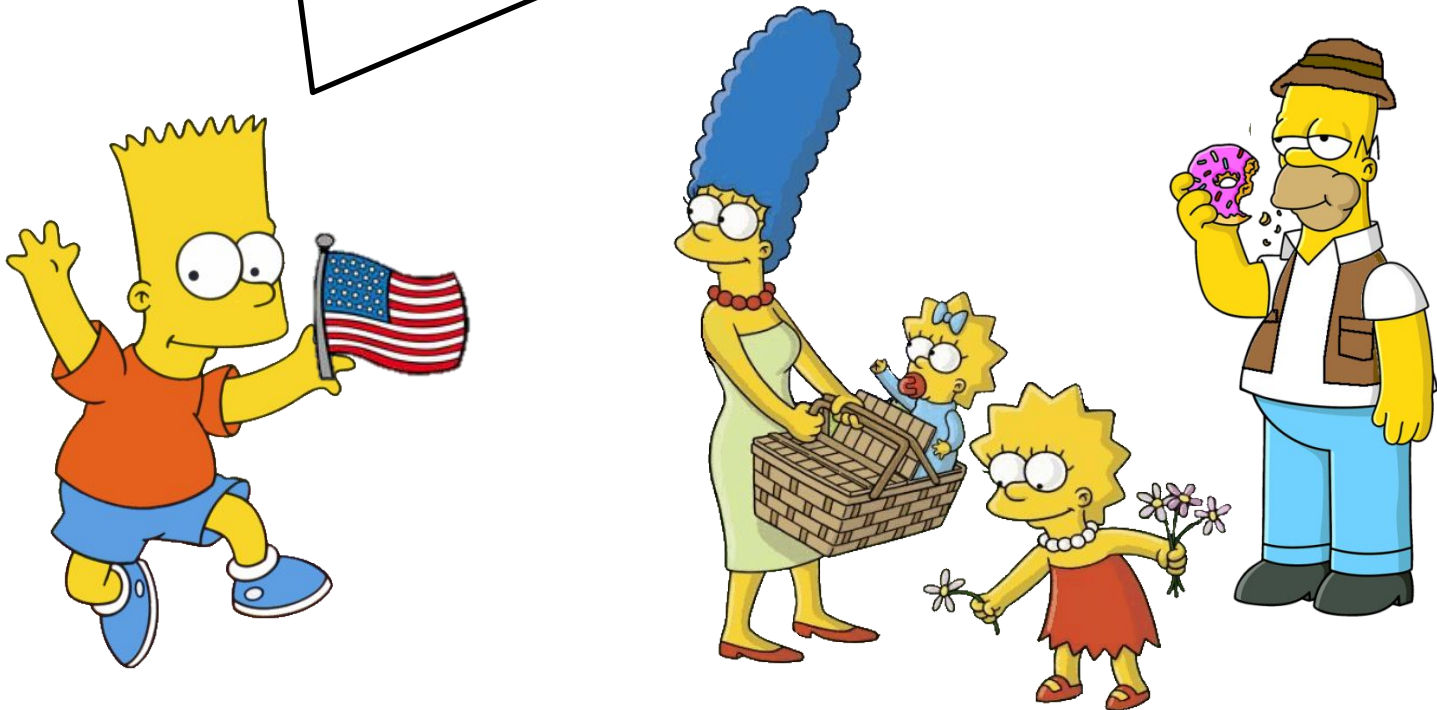

Verb TO Be AFFIRMATIVE

I **am** Bart.

I **am** with my family.

I'**m** American.

You are my friend.
You're a good boy.

AFFIRMATIVE

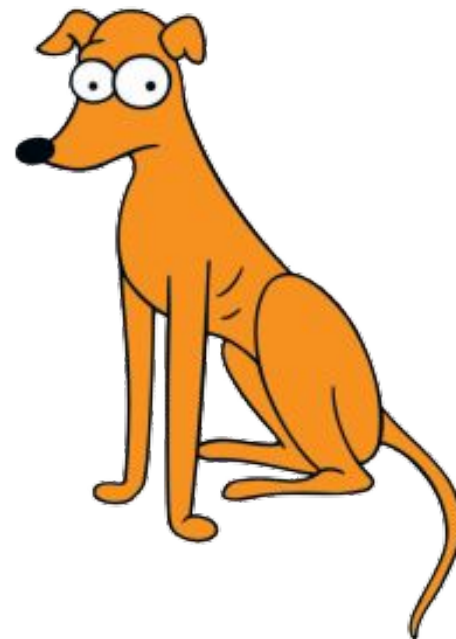
She **is** Marge.

We're at school.

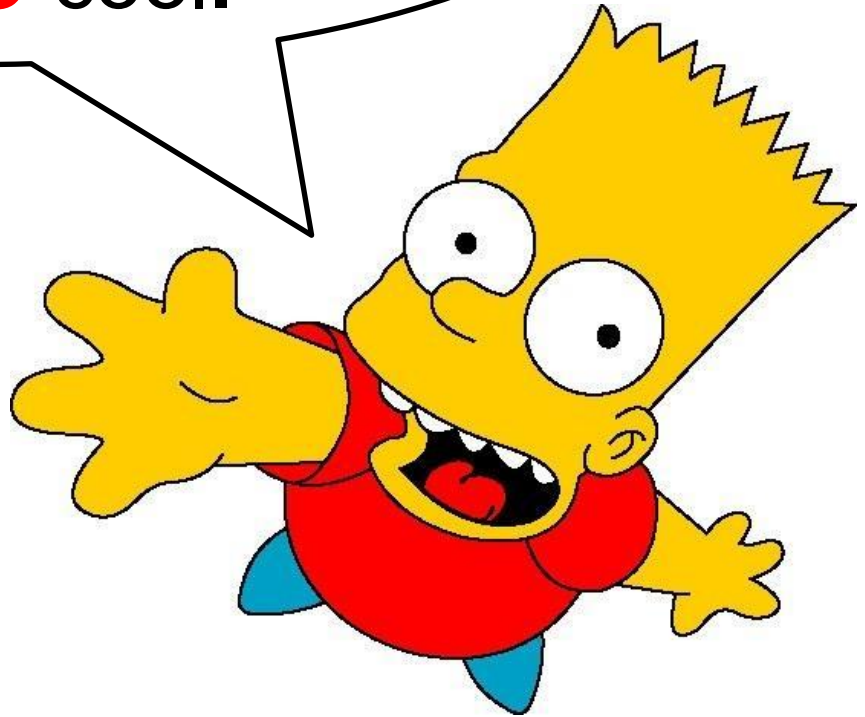


Verb TO Be AFFIRMATIVE

You and your friends

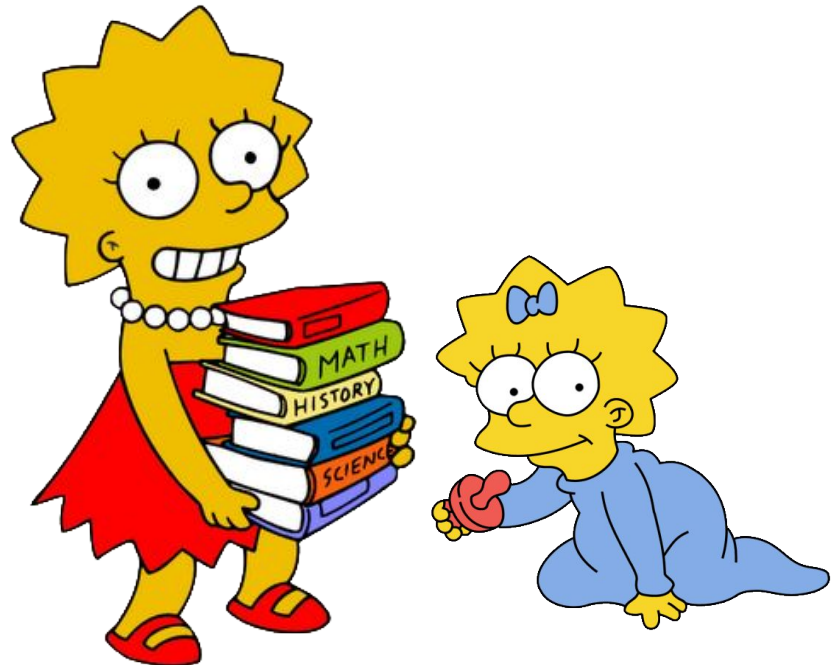
are students.

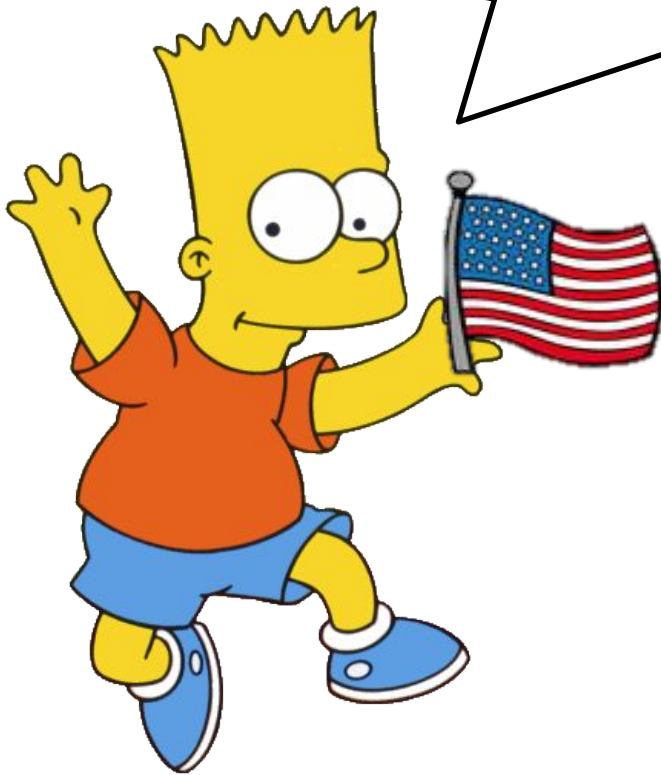

She **is not** Marge.
She **isn't** my mom.



Verb TO Be NEGATIVE

We are not from Mexico.

We aren't Mexican.



Verb TO Be NEGATIVE

I'm not

You aren't

He isn't

She isn't

It isn't

We aren't

You aren't

They aren't

Verb TO Be INTERROGATIVE

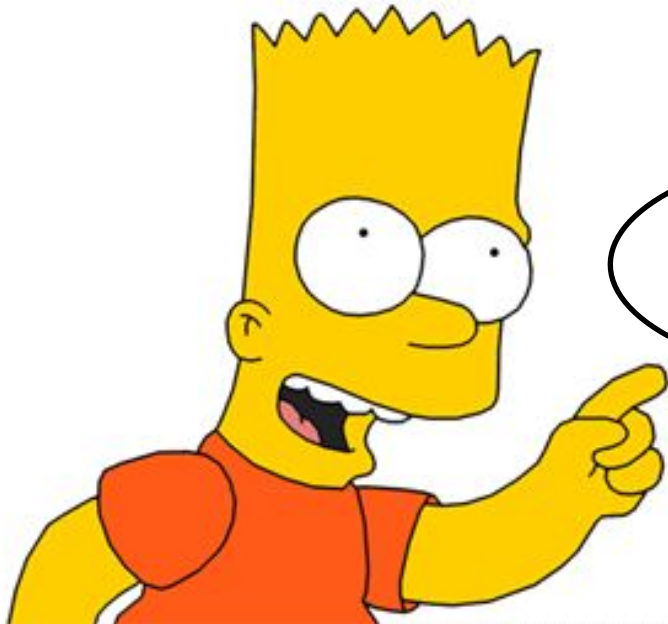
Am I your best friend?

Yes, **you are**.



Verb TO Be INTERROGATIVE

Are you my teacher?



Yes, I **am**.

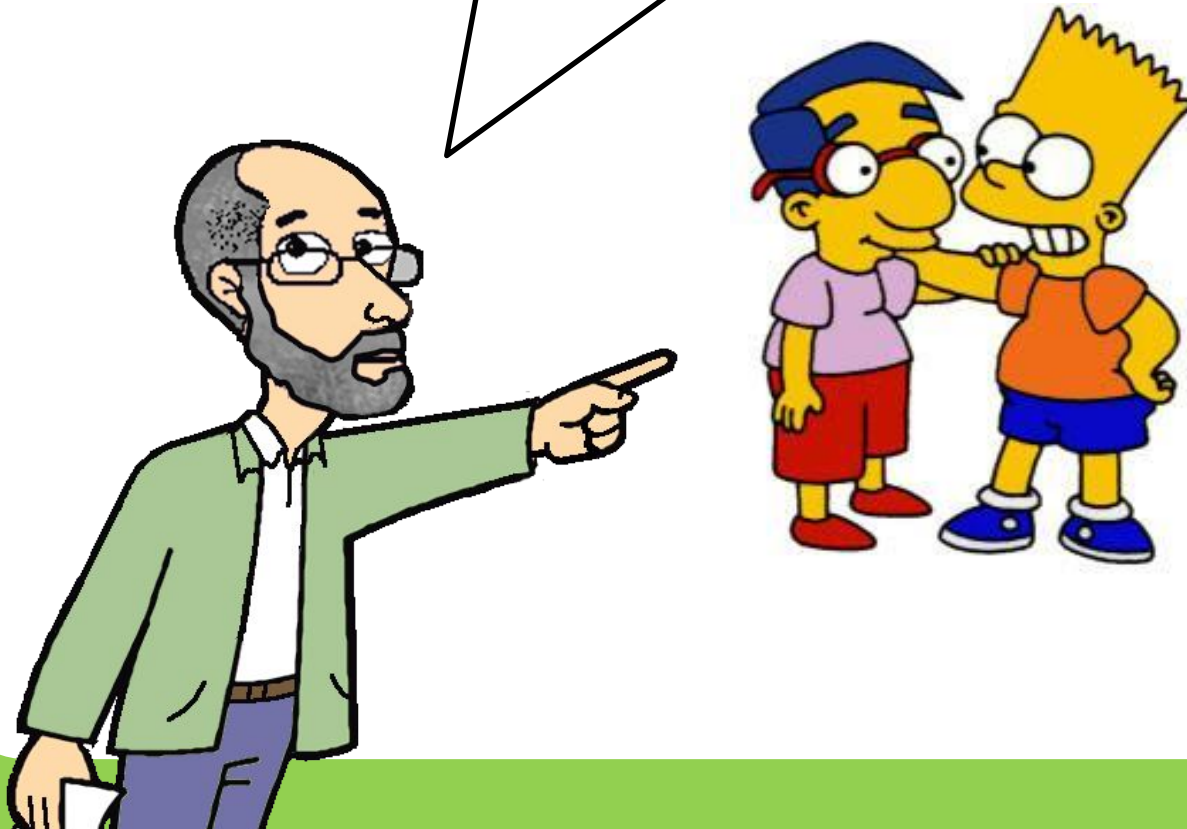
