

Shakespeare's birthplace in Henley Street. John Shakespeare lived and kept his shop in this house. His eight children were born here. Two of them died young.






"... around forty boys would have been taught in this room ..."

New Globe theatre.








This is the Holy Trinity Church where Shakespeare was buried. It is interesting that he died on his birthday, 23 April, 1616.
