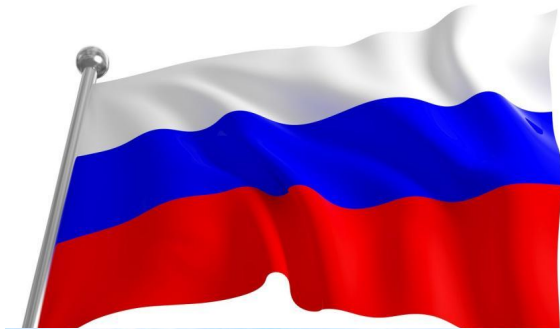



Clothes for Russia

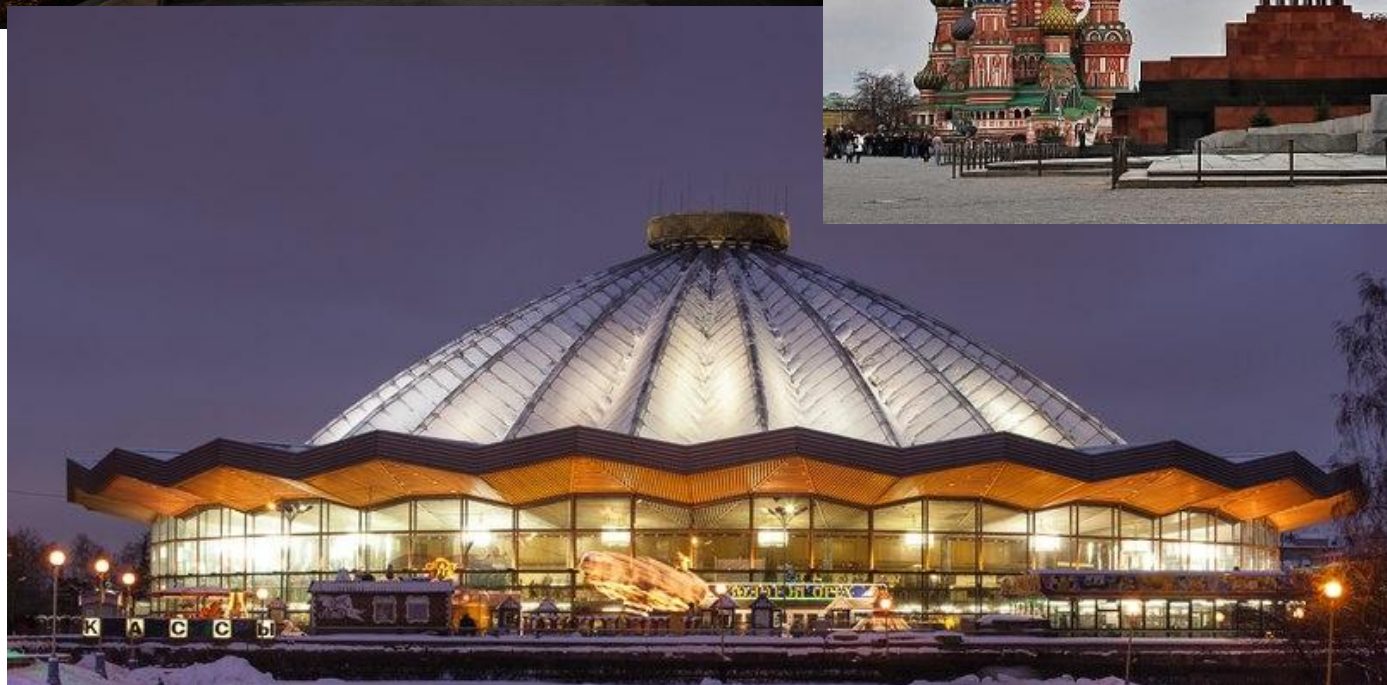
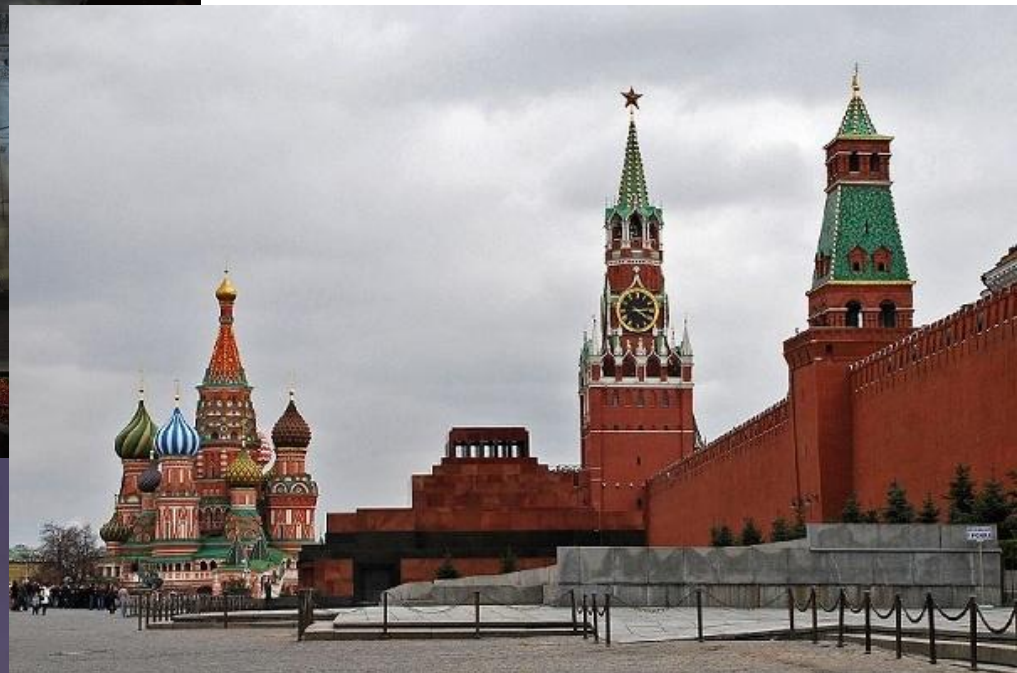
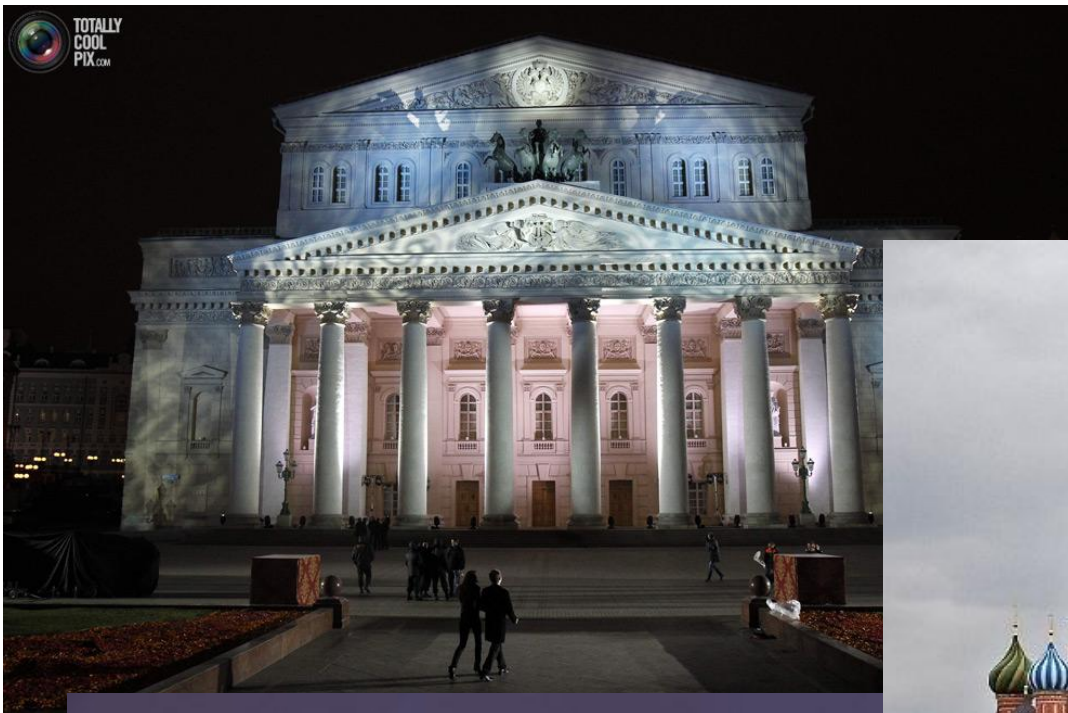
