К основе глагола добавляется окончание –ed. to like- liked to watch- watched



Подлежащее + DIDN'T + глагол в неопр. форме <u>без</u> частицы to + второст.члены предложения.

- 1) Она не выключила компьютер вчера. She didn't switch the computer off yesterday.
- 2) Ee жизнь не была скучной. Her life wasn't boring.
- 3) Он не отправил письмо 2 дня **Ha**3**didn't sent the letter 2 days ago.**

### ВОПРОСИТЕЛЬНЫЕ ПРЕДЛОЖЕНИЯ

DID + подлежащее + глагол в неопред.форме без частицы to + второст.члены предложения?

Yes, ... did.

No, .... didn't.

Did you watch TV yesterday?

Did you go to the shop last weekend?




