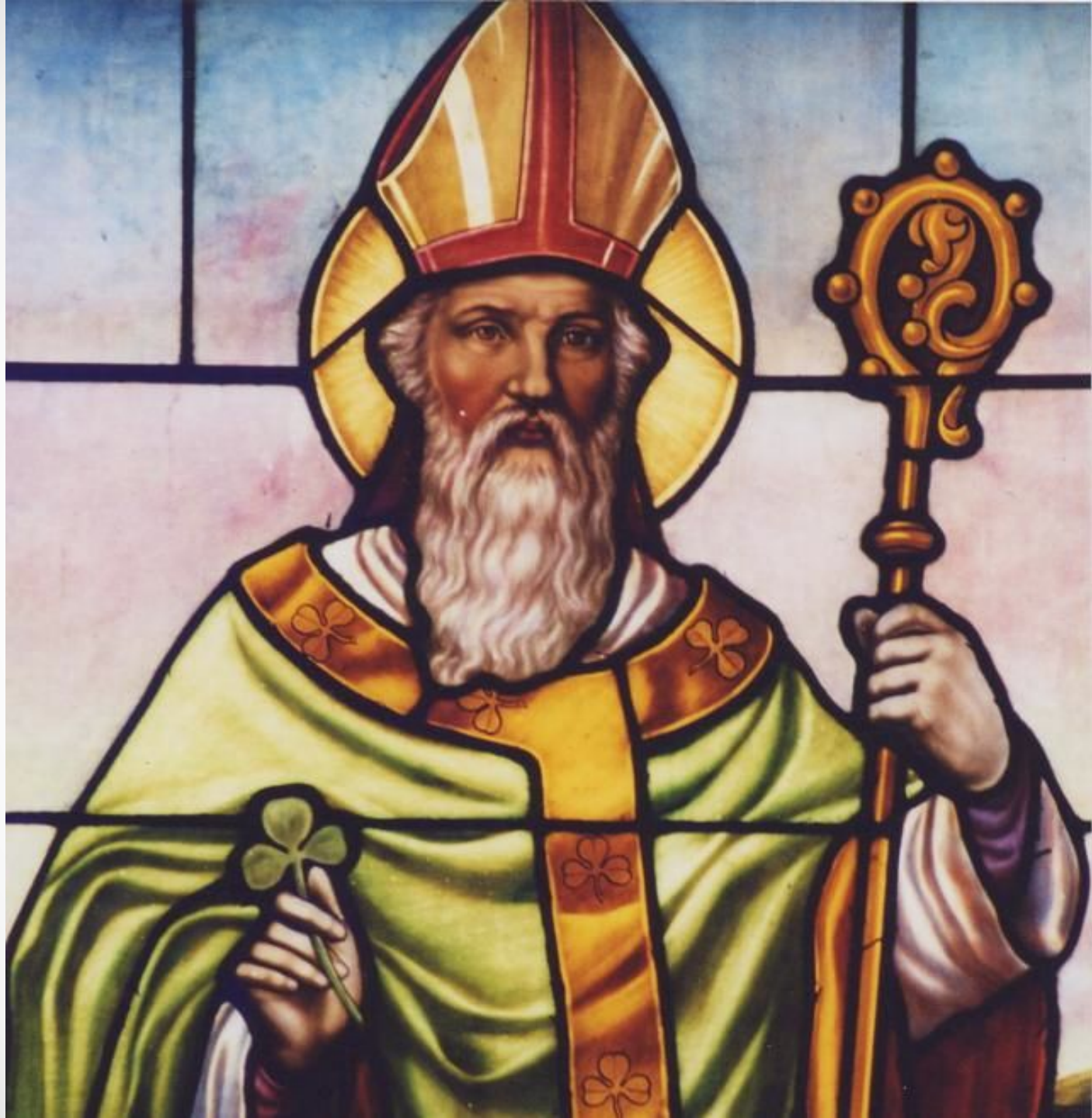

Who was Saint Patrick?

- Patron Saint of Ireland
- Born in the 4th century on the island of Great Britain
- At the age of 16, he was kidnapped by Irish pirates and taken to Ireland
- Stayed in Ireland for 6 years, learned Gaelic and the customs
- Escaped and returned home
- Became a priest and returned to Ireland as missionary

Shamrock



Who was Saint Patrick

- Introduced Christianity to the Irish people
- Used a shamrock to explain the Christian idea of the Trinity
- According to legend, banished all snakes from the island of Ireland
- St. Patrick died on March 17
