<i>The Wonderful Wizard of Oz</i> by L. Frank Baum	1928 1958	Chicago Public Libraries Detroit	“ungodly”; “for depicting women in strong leadership roles.” “no value for children of today.”
<i>Winnie-the-Pooh</i> by A. A. Milne	2006	parts of the US	talking animals are considered an “insult to god”
<i>Harriet the Spy</i> by Louise Fitzhugh	1983	several US schools	“a bad example for children”, teach “children to lie, spy, talk back, and curse”
<i>Anne Frank: The Diary of a Young Girl</i> by Anne Frank	2010	several US schools	“too depressing”
<i>Alice in Wonderland</i> by Lewis Carroll	1960-s	Thousand institutions	in fear that it would promote drug use to children
<i>The Merriam-Webster Dictionary</i>	2010	California, some classes	Definition of ‘oral sex’



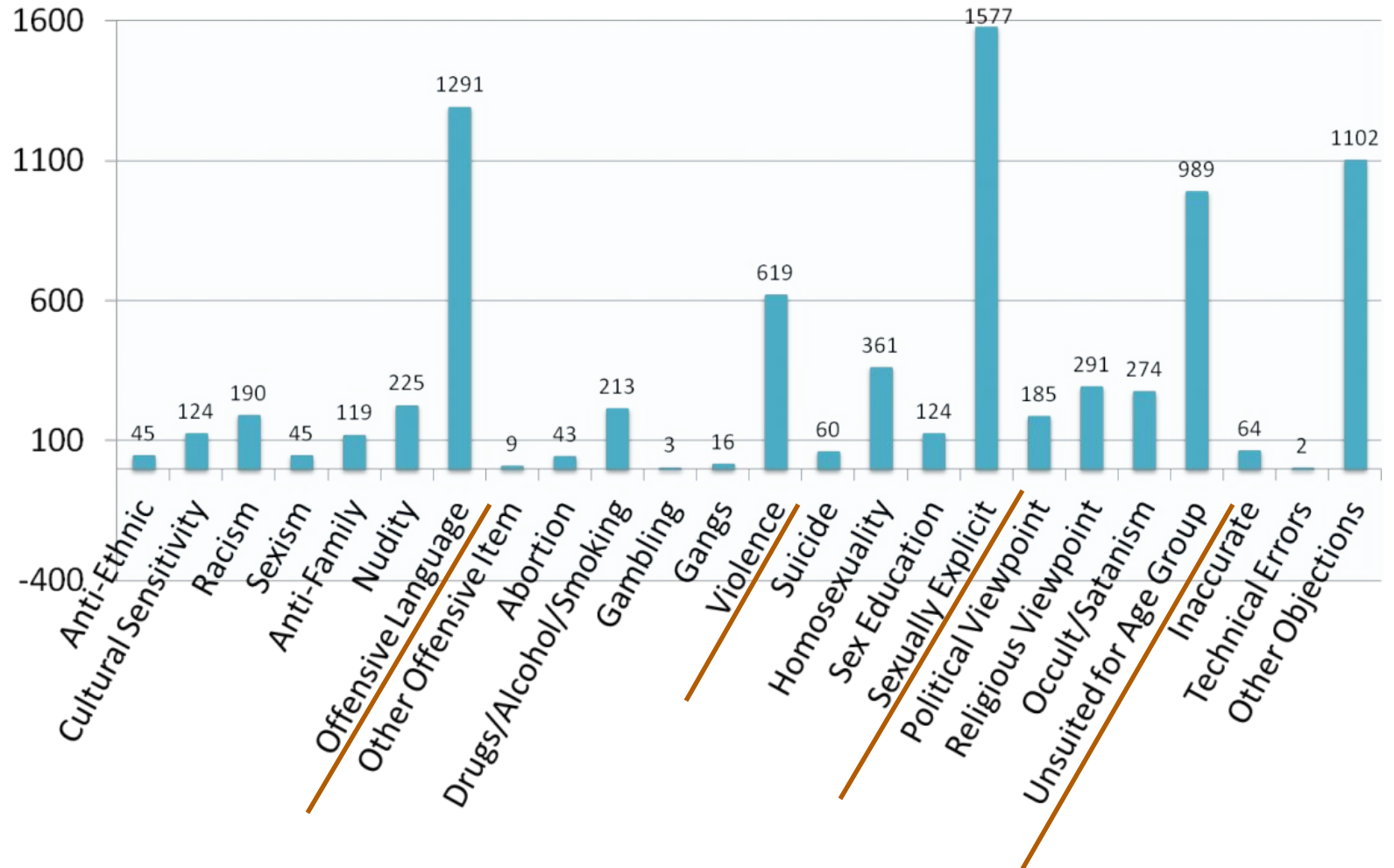
Challenges by Institution, 2000-09

Правовые основания

- “the Government may not prohibit the expression of an idea simply because society finds the idea itself offensive or disagreeable.” *Texas v. Johnson*, 109 S. Ct. 2533 (1989).
- Under a 1982 Supreme Court ruling, school administrators may regulate library content based on “educational suitability,” but may not do so to suppress ideas or instill political orthodoxy (*Board of Education v. Pico*).

Amendment I

Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof; or abridging the **freedom of speech**, or of the press; or the right of the people peaceably to assemble, and to petition the government for a redress of grievances.
