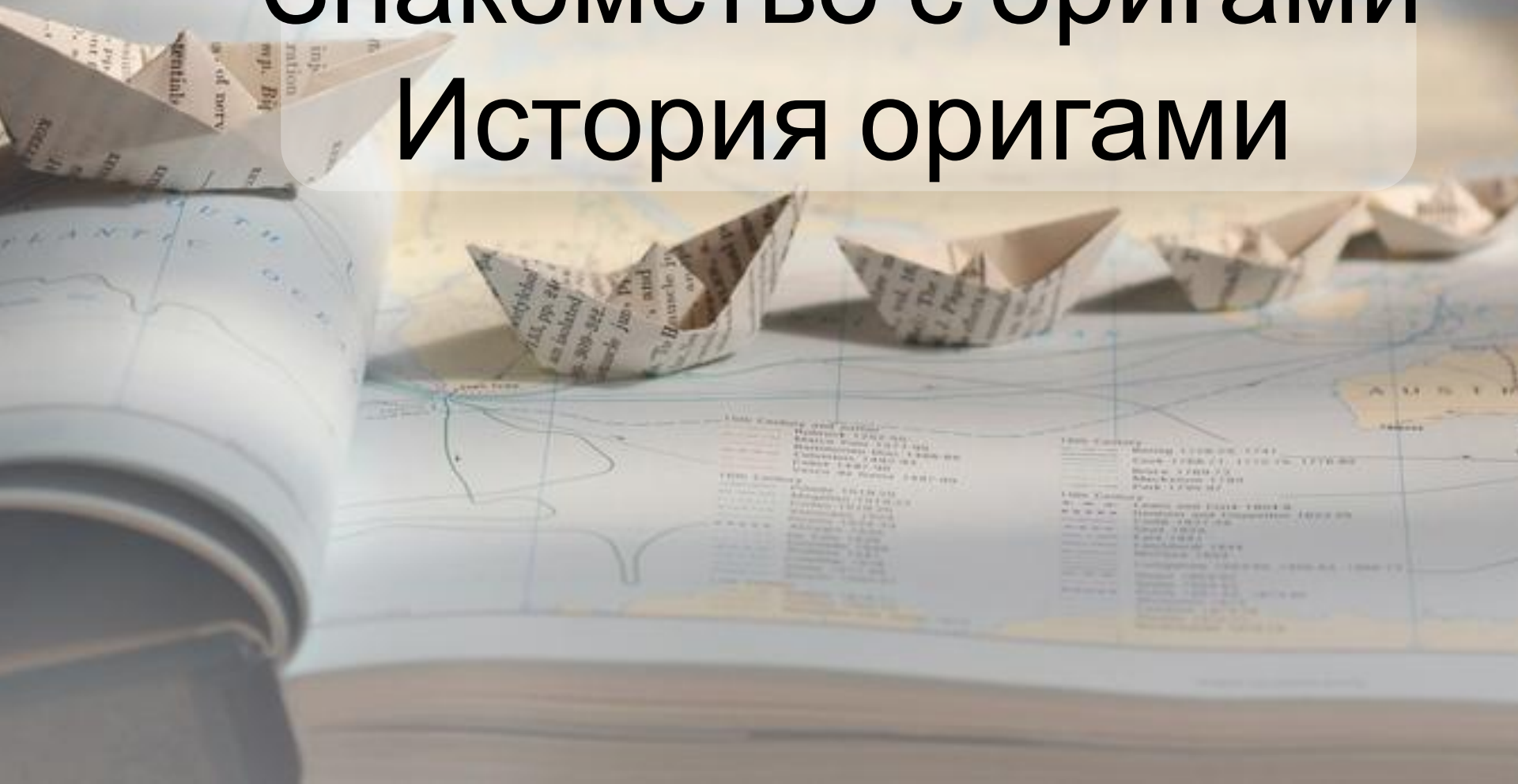


Знакомство с оригами

История оригами





Слово **ОРИГАМИ** (折り紙) в переводе с японского означает "сложенная бумага" (*ори-ками*)

Ори – "складывать"

Ками – "бумага", и "Бог"

Массовость искусство оригами приобрело лишь в XII-X веках. Бумажные фигурки стали использоваться во время свадебных церемоний и праздничных шествий или в качестве украшений для дома.

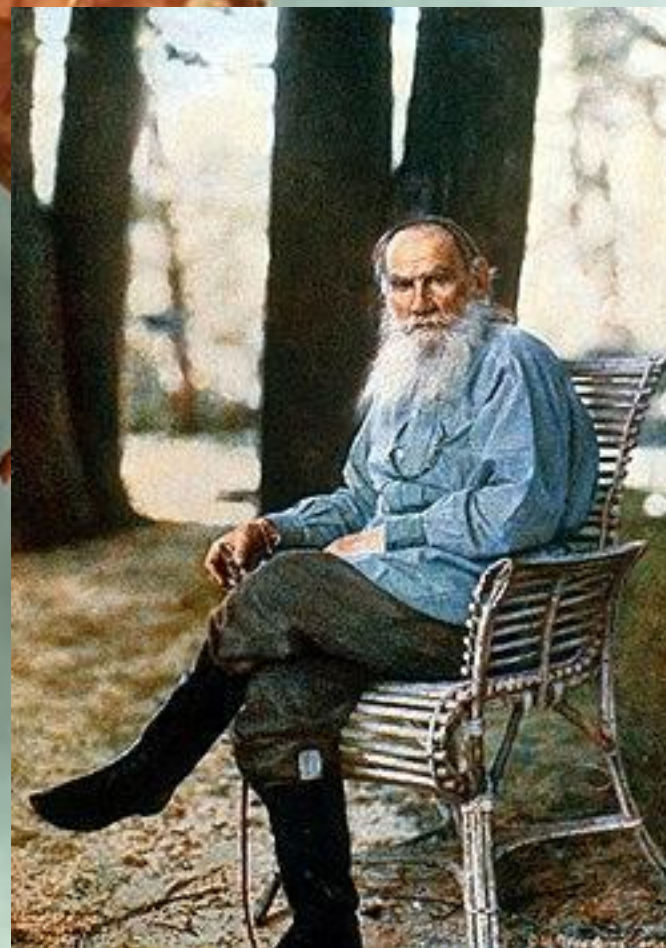


Записки, сложенные в форме бабочки, журавля, цветка или абстрактной геометрической фигуры были знаком дружбы или доброго пожелания для любимого человека
