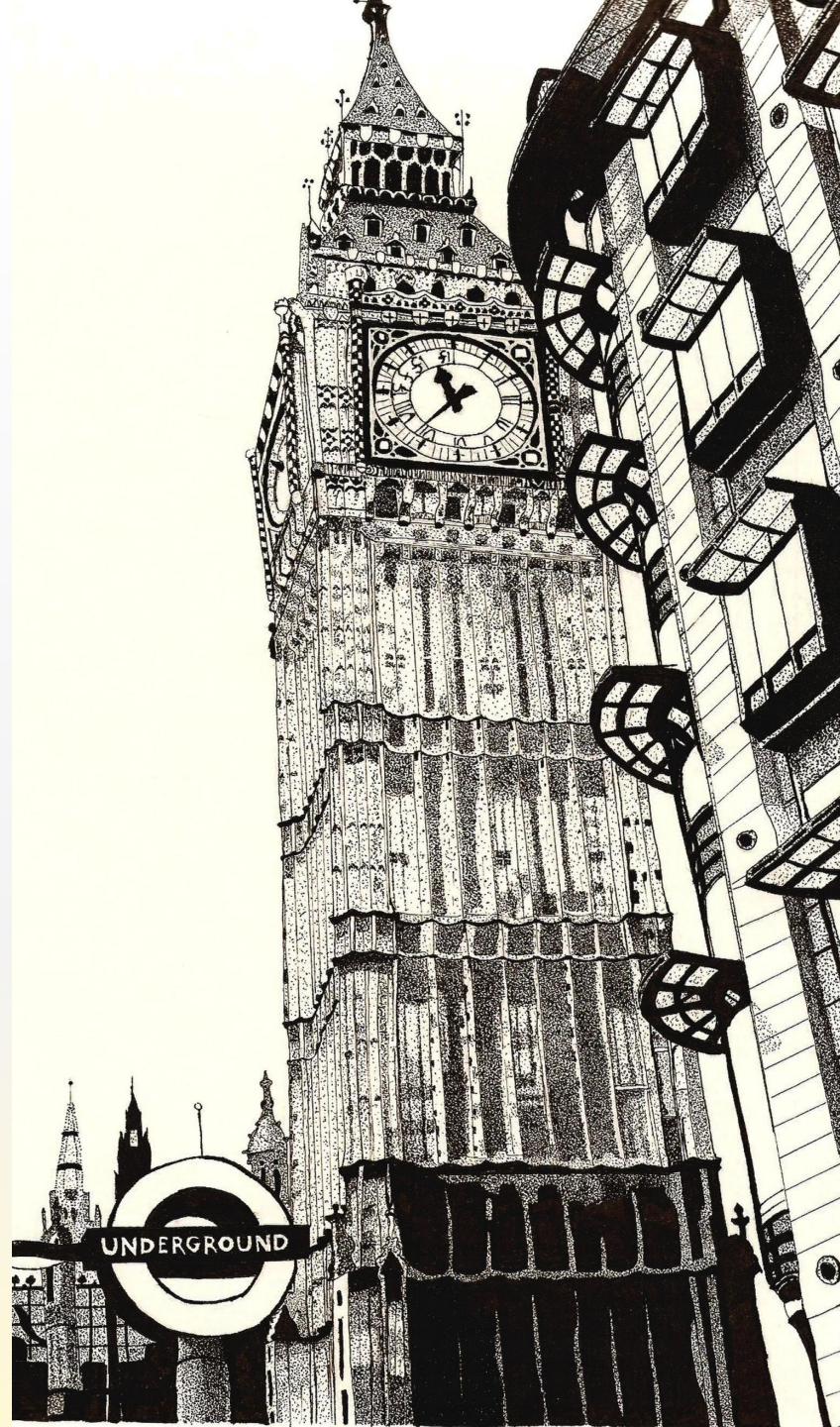

- It takes time around 2
- Cost: around £45 (Trainline.com)

■ COACH

- Take bus at Poole, Bournemouth or Parkstone
- Arrival at London Victoria
- It takes time around 3 hours
- Cost: around £20 (Nationalexpress.com)

- *London is divided into 6 zones; fares differ depending on which zones you travel.*

□ *Buses*

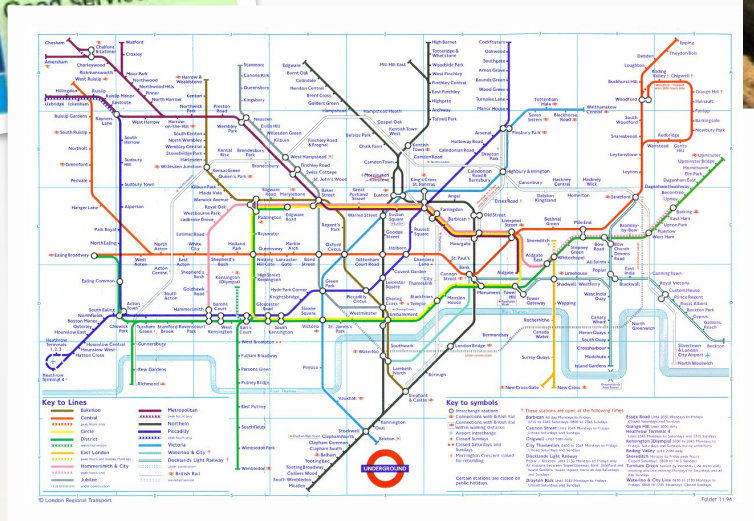
□ *NATIONAL RAIL WAY*

- *You may be charged penalty fare (£50) if you travel further than your ticket allows.*
- *Make sure which zone your ticket is available before you travel*

Tube - Underground

- There are 11 different lines and each lines have own color. You can get the free tube map at the tube stations which will help you.





Buses

Standard cost- £2.

One day ticket - £3.80

Also night busses are available which may be useful if you are going out until past one or two am.



NATIONAL RAIL WAY

*This is useful if you want to travel in the suburbs of London.
Also you can access tube from rail way station.*




Taxis

*Back cabs are an expensive option unless there are three or more of you. The minimum fare is £2.2
This is useful if you get lost*

Accommodation

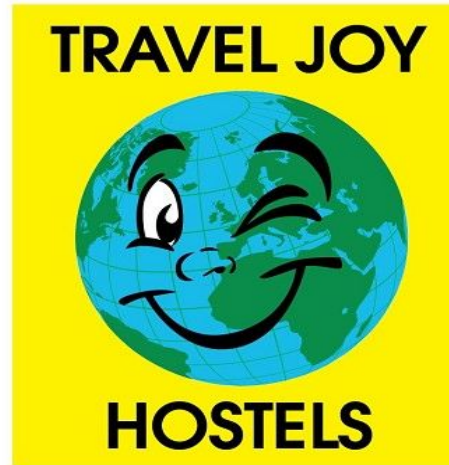
- London is a giant city, so it helps to understand the layout before you arrive. Look at our summary to get a head start.
