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What is Model-UN?



Model United Nations is an academic simulation of the United Nations that aims to educate participants about current global issues, topics in IR, diplomacy, and the UN agenda and procedure.

What do they do in a MUN?

- * The participants role-play as diplomats representing a NGO or country in a simulated session of a committee of the UN, such as the Security Council or the General Assembly.
- * These delegates research a country, take on roles as diplomats, investigate global issues, debate, consult, and develop solutions to world problems.



Which skills will be used and improved?

- * During the conference, participants must employ a variety of communication skills in order to represent policies of a country.

- * These skills include public speaking, team work, research, policy analysis, conflict resolution, negotiating, active listening, note taking, and technical writing.



Mission and vision

Goals: The purpose for organizing MUN is listed but not limited to following:

- To introduce the United Nations structure and procedures (especially Security Council's environment and the General Assembly) to future leaders of the country;
- To encourage students for taking part and discuss about vital and critical challenges in the current world;
- To improve positivism by creating team work among participants from different ethnics and cities in a multicultural workshop;

Aim: To give an opportunity for youth to raise their voice, join in decision making and share their opinions about the key issues discussed in international level.

Who delegates and how?

MUNs are for students of Law & IR department, as well as Journalism and Economy Faculties, activists of Civil Society and members of NGOs, as future leader of country.

Each participant will represent 1 country. Delegates will present position of their countries, and after formal and informal debates, they will raise resolution.



More about MUNs

The Model UN trainings are designed to teach students the inner workings of UN. Participants represent the member countries in a simulation game by playing the diplomatic debate of one or more UN committees as real delegates.

The purpose of this program is to find common / effective solutions on the issues on the agenda by signing and approval of a number of resolutions...

Modern method of teaching (Simulation Games)

- * A **simulation game** attempts to copy various activities from "real life" in the form of a game for various purposes such as training, analysis, or prediction. Well-known examples are role play simulation.
- * From three basic types of strategic, planning, and learning exercises: (games, simulations, and case studies), a number of hybrids may be considered, including simulation games that are used as case studies.
- * In a **Roleplay simulation**, learners take on the role profiles of specific characters or organizations in a contrived setting. Roleplay is widely acknowledged as a powerful teaching technique
- * Roleplay is designed primarily to build first person experience in a workgroup and supportive environment.
