## Relative pronouns and adverbs

## Relative pronouns (who, whose, whom, which, that) and relative adverbs (where, when, why)

- •are used to introduce a relative clause in the sentence.
- •come after a noun.

Relative Pronoun	Use	Example
who	person (subject)	A vet who got the first prize is Russian.
whose	possession	That's the boy whose father is a famous writer.
whom	person (object)	The old woman whom I helped was Mary's grandma.
which	things	The book which he gave me is very boring.
that	things persons	A vet <b>that</b> got the first prize is Russian. The book <b>that</b> he gave me is very boring.

Relative Adverb	Use	Example
where	place	The camp <b>where</b> we first met is still our favourite place to go to.
when	time	That was the year <b>when</b> we went on holiday to Greece.
why	reason	The reason why she went is still a mystery.
