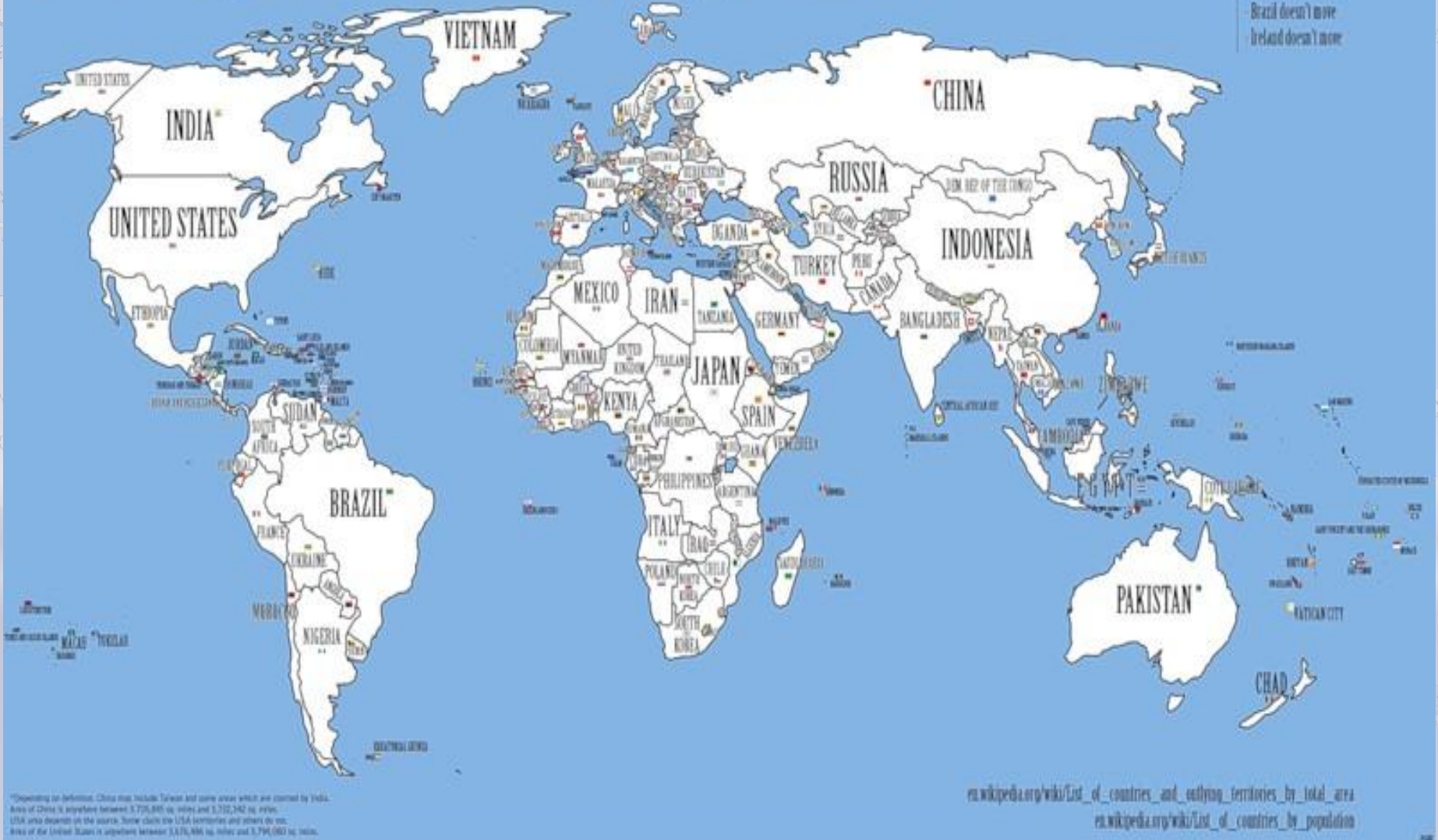

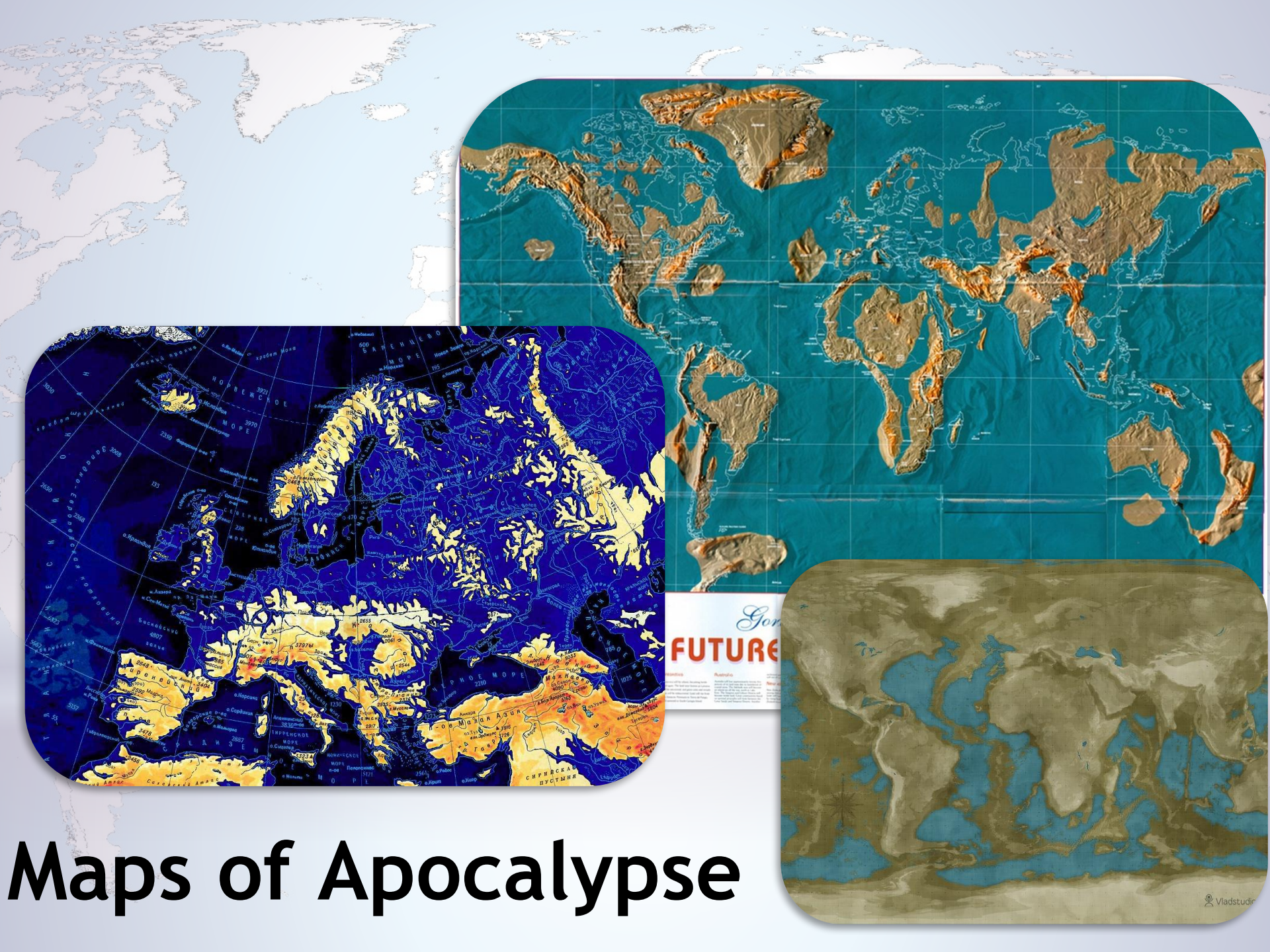

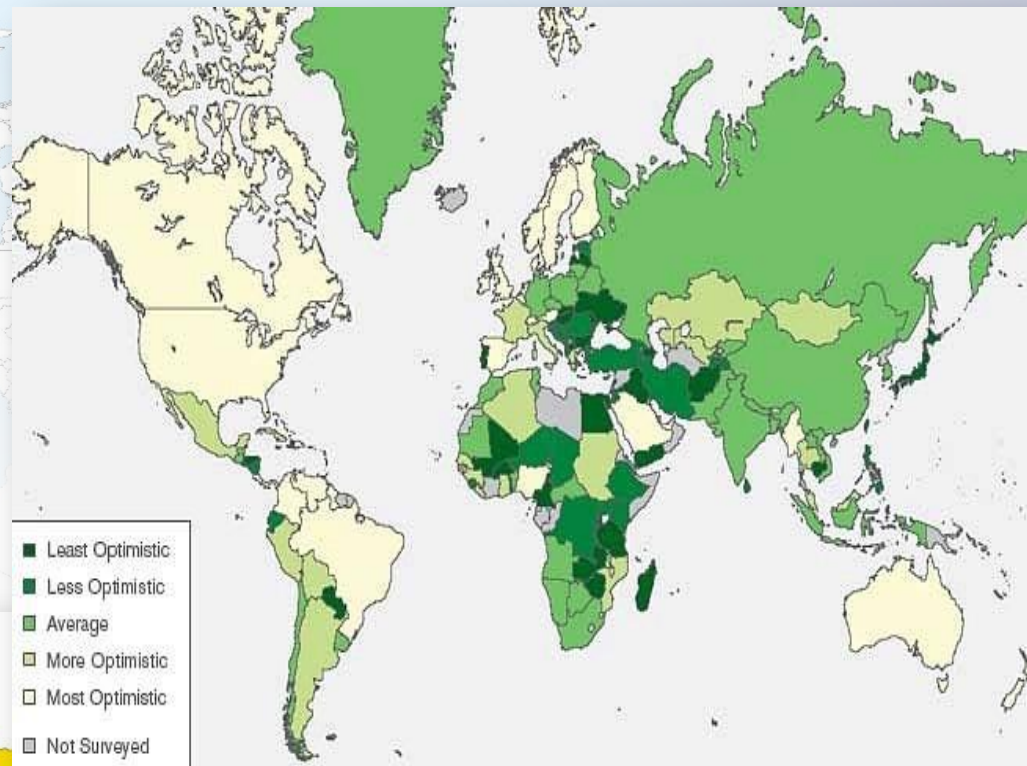

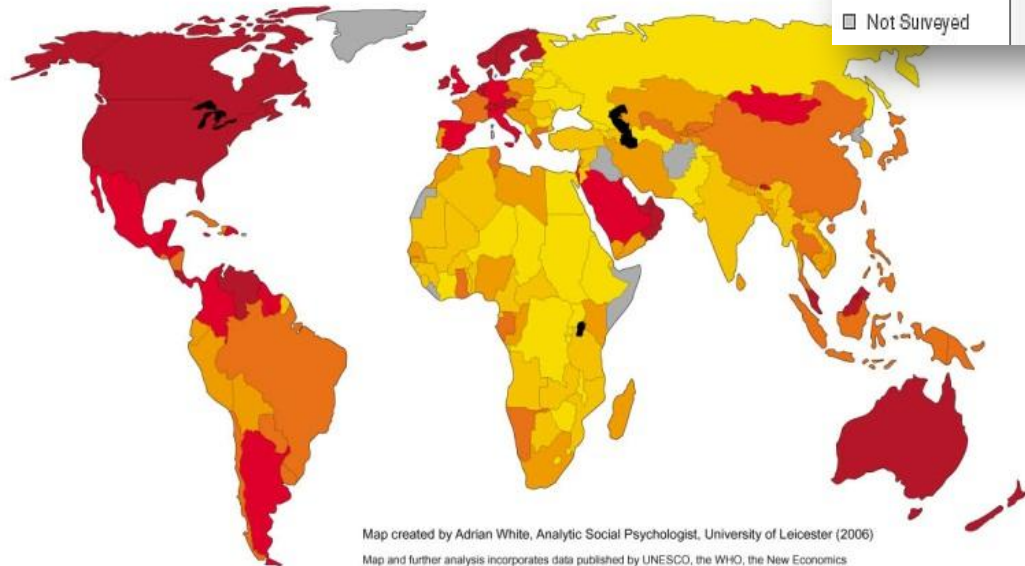

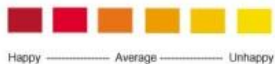


A Global Projection of Subjective Well-being:
The First Published Map of World Happiness



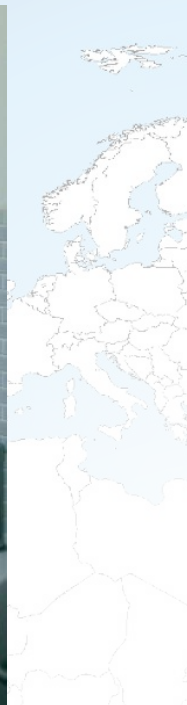
