


The Past Tense

My name is Bart. I have a large family. I have

Sally has two sisters.

5. Aveţi verișori? <u>Do you have cousins?</u>

6. Aveţi o mătușă? Do you have an aunt?

Present Tense

I am twenty-five years old.

Do you have grandparents?

I do not have grandparents.

Past Tense (+)

Regular verbs in the past tense are made by adding –ed to the original verb.

to talk (a vorbi)

I often talk to my grandmother.



talked

I talked to my grandmother yesterday.


Do you talk to your uncles often?



Did you talk to your uncles last week?

Negative Sentences (-)

I <u>do not</u> talk to my uncles often.



I <u>did not</u> talk to my uncles last week.

Irregular Verbs

Unfortunately, there are no rules for irregular verbs. You just have to learn them.



More Irregular Verbs

take* took come came wake (up) woke made make-- делать / **ГОТОВИТЬ** read read got get*

More Irregulars!

to be (am, is, are) was, were

to do did

to have had

Signal Words yesterday

last (week, weekend month, year)

a (week, month, year) ago

<u>in</u> 2010

this morning

Examples

What did you do <u>yesterday</u>?

I was born *in 1989*.

I went to my friend's house last weekend.

When do we use past simple?

1. action finished in the past (single or repeated)

I visited Berlin last week.
Andrew watched TV yesterday.

2. series of completed actions in the past

First I got up, then I had breakfast.
