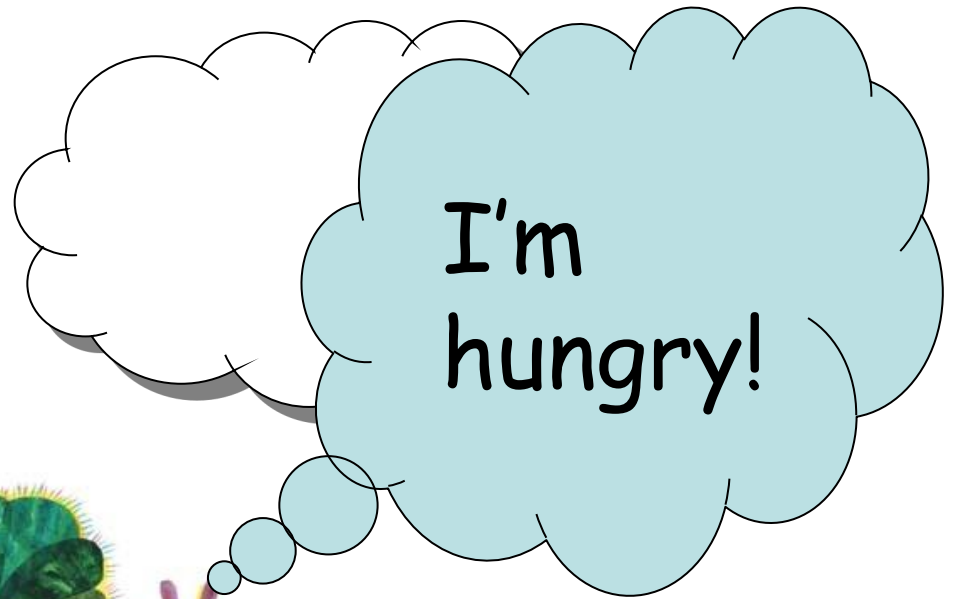
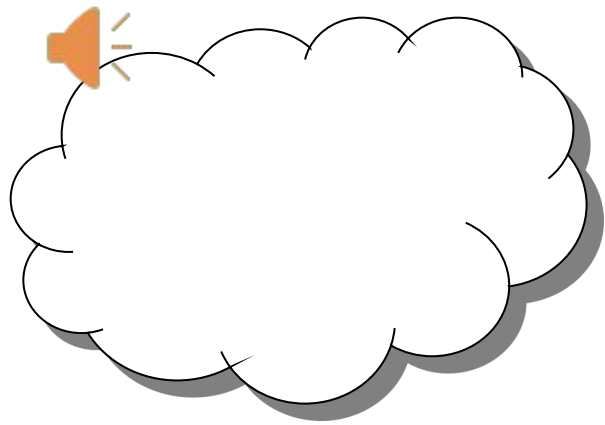


A little egg is on a leaf.

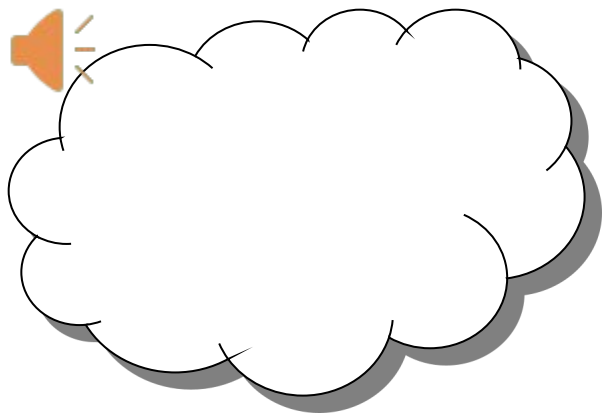


One day, Out of the egg came a tiny

He started to look for some food.

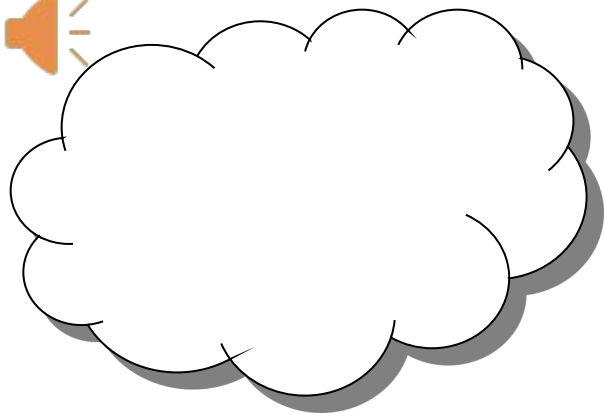


I'm still hungry!

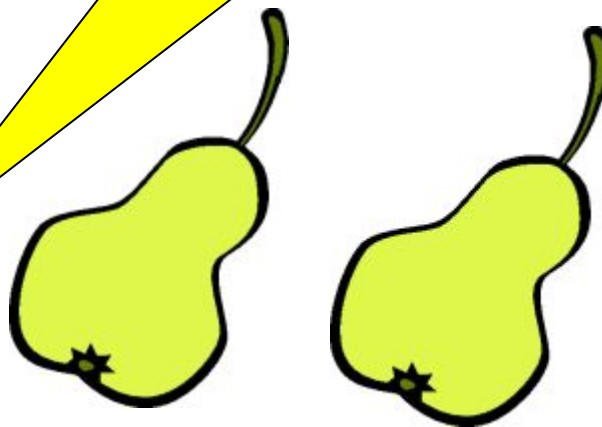


He ate one apple. But he was still hungry.





I'm still hungry!



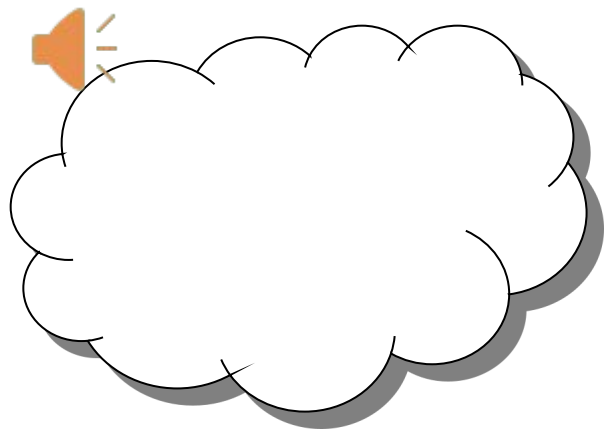
He ate two pears, but he was still hungry.



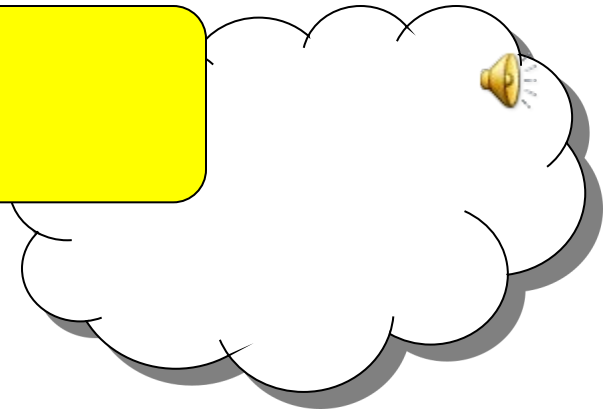
He ate three plums, but he was still hungry.

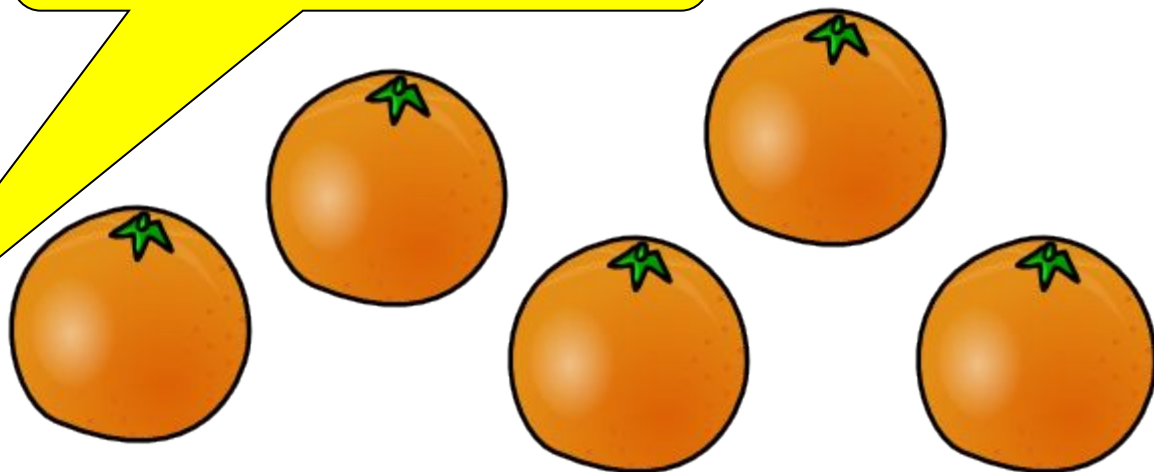
He ate four strawberries, but he was still hungry.



He ate five oranges, but he was still hungry.

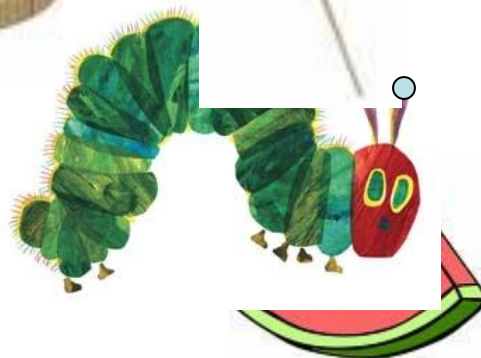

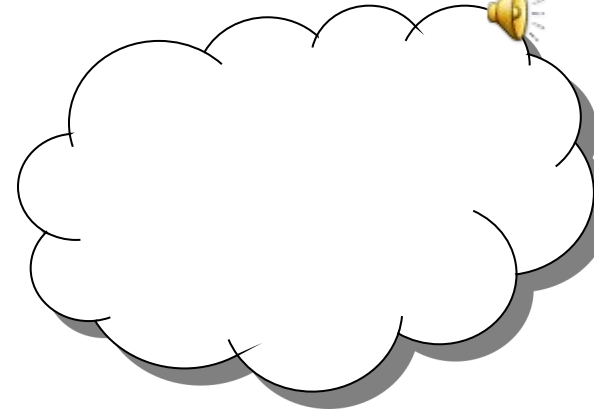
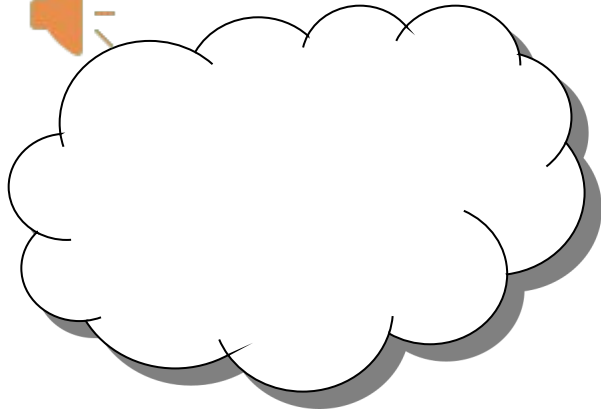




He ate ...

Now he is full, and isn't a little caterpillar any more.

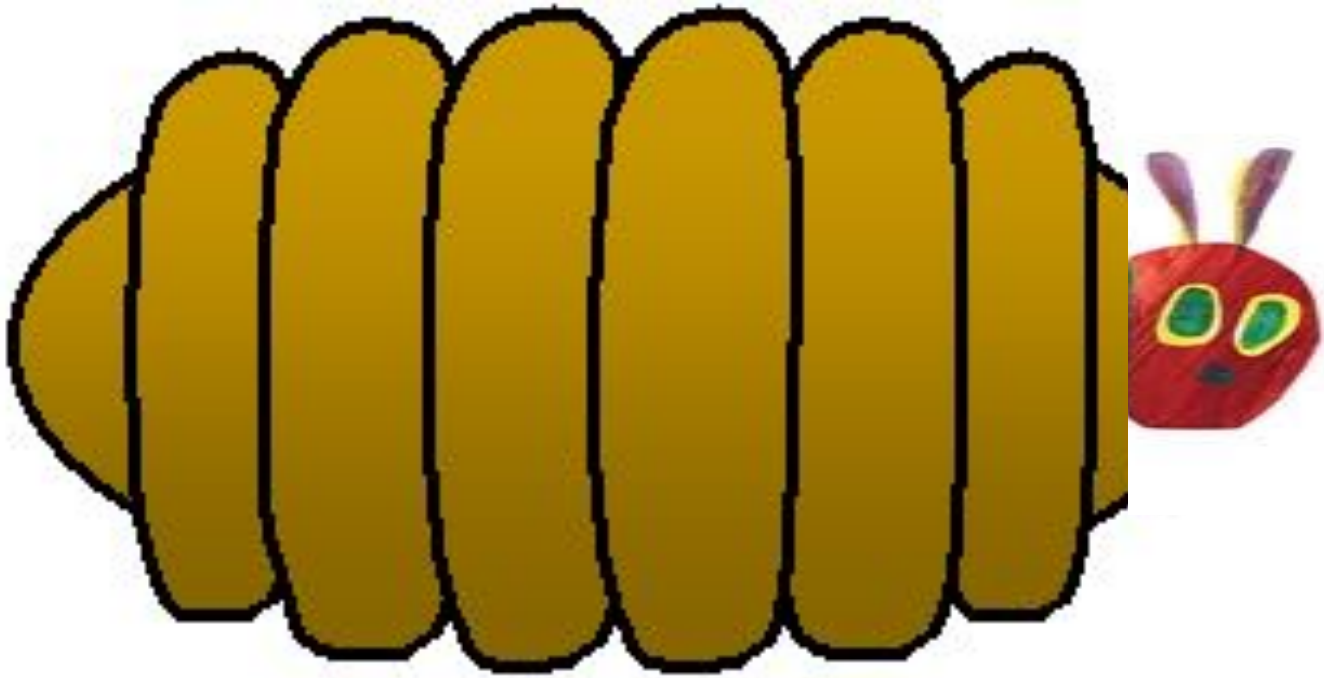


He was a big, fat caterpillar.
