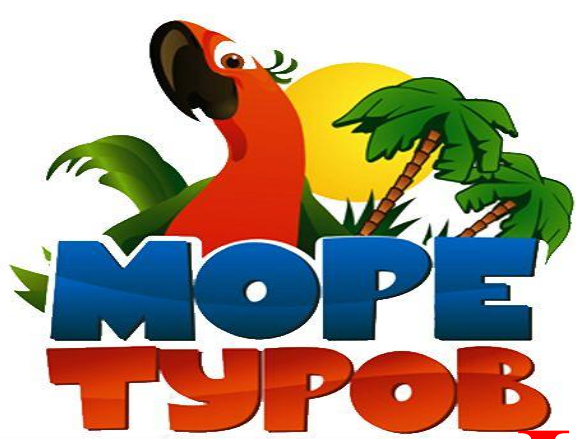

<i>Everything</i> is good in its season. Все хорошо в свое время.	I cannot see <i>anything</i> on the table. Я ничего не вижу на столе.
