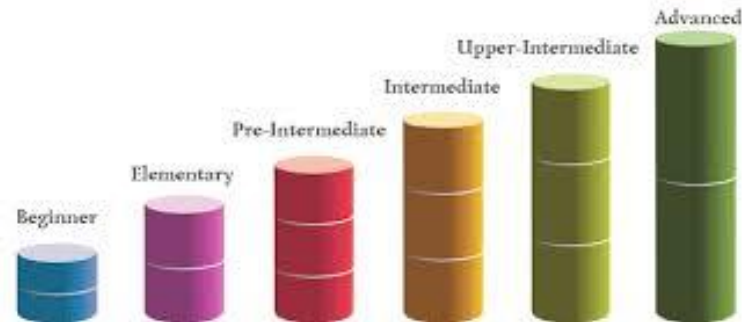

is a test that measures the language proficiency of people who want to study or work in environments where English is used as a language of communication.

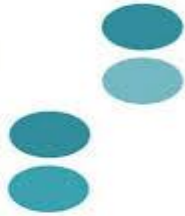
available in 2 formats: **Academic and General Training**

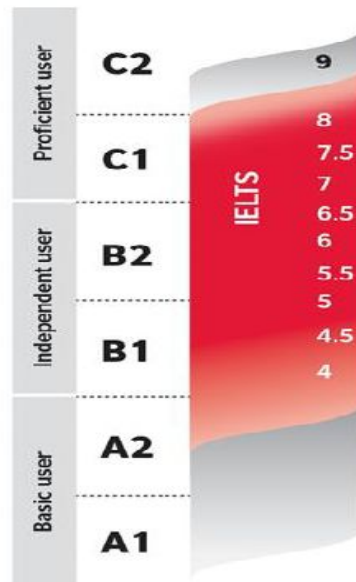

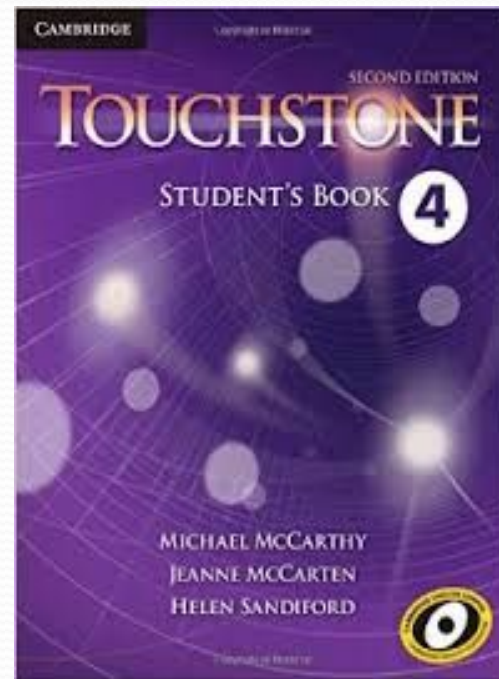

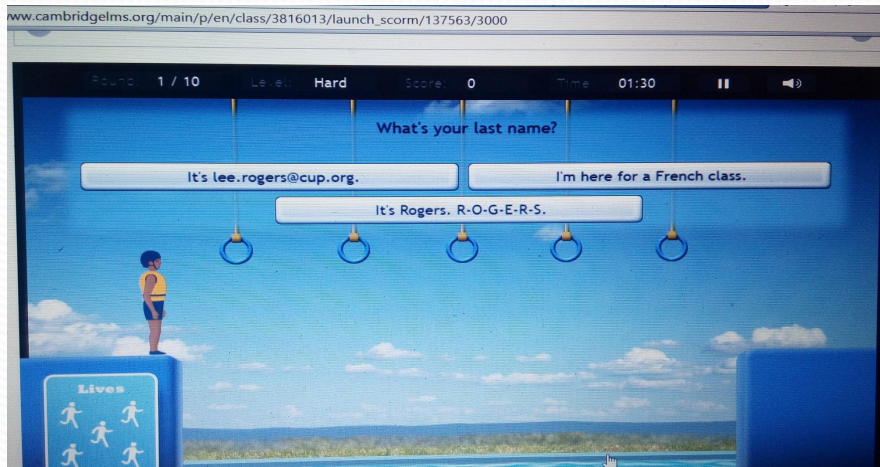
